Foreign Student Enrollment
1958-59

Ten years ago, three hundred and five foreign students were pursuing their studies at Cornell. This year our enrollment has reached seven hundred and nine students from seventy nine different countries, an increase of sixty nine over last year. Graduate students account for most of the increase. Four hundred and sixty eight are studying at the graduate level with the greatest concentration in the College of Agriculture.

The graduate students are listed according to the college in which they are doing their major study rather than classing them all as in the Graduate School without regard to their field.

The area listing of students from different countries and their distribution in the colleges and schools is attached. When available, the department enrollment figures with the school or college have been tabulated.
