## Foreign Student Enrollment 1960-61

The attached is a brief summary of the foreign student enrollment at Cornell for the academic year 1960-61.

Our enrollment continues to increase and this year we have 791 foreign students coming to us from 81 countries. The percentage of foreign students to the total student enrollment is 7.3%.

Five hundred and seventy-one foreign students are enrolled as graduate students making up 23.1% of the total graduate student enrollment. This includes those students enrolled in The Graduate School as well as Master's degree candidates in the Graduate School of Business and Public Administration, the Graduate School of Aeronautical Engineering, and the Law School.

Two hundred and twenty foreign students are enrolled in the undergraduate division of the University making up 2.6% of the total undergraduate enrollment. The School of Hotel Administration leads with foreign students making up 10.4% of their total undergraduate enrollment, and Architecture and Agriculture follow with 7.0% and 4.7% respectively.

According to figures released by the Institute of International Education for the year 1959-60, Cornell ranks tenth among U.S. universities in total number of foreign students and, with 6.2%, ranked third in percentage of foreign students to total enrollment. Howard University and M.I.T. had 13.6% and 12.4% respectively. It is also interesting to note that in the academic year 1960-61, 48,486 foreign students studied in this country, and eighteen institutions reported enrollments of over four hundred foreign students.

For those who may be interested in other facts and figures related to Cornell's international exchange activities, I might mention that last year eighty persons from abroad were members of our faculty as visiting professors, research associates, etc., and forty-nine Cornell faculty members were engaged in teaching and research activities abroad.
