FOREIGN STUDENT ENROLLMENT 1962-63

We are pleased to present a brief summary of the foreign student enrollment at Cornell for the academic year 1962-63. Our enrollment of foreign students has increased by 10% over last year and represents the largest number ever to enroll at Cornell. This year we have 874 students representing 85 countries. The three largest national groups are Canada (122), India (91), and China (71).

The percentage of foreign students to total student enrollment is 7.5. Graduate students (645) make up 73.5% of the foreign student enrollment. The foreign graduate students comprise 25.2% of the total graduate student enrollment. This includes those students enrolled in the Graduate School and Master's degree candidates in the Graduate Schools of Business and Public Administration, Aerospace Engineering, and the Law School.

Our undergraduate enrollment increased by only 31 students over last year. Foreign students represent 2.6% of the total undergraduate enrollment. The School of Hotel Administration maintains the highest percentage (11.6) of foreign students of any undergraduate division, followed by the College of Architecture with 7.4%, and the College of Agriculture with 3.7%.

For those interested in some of the national figures related to enrollment of foreign students, we quote some of the findings from the 1961-62 census conducted by the Institute of International Education and summarized in their publication "Open Doors". There were over 58,000 students from 149 countries studying in 1,798 institutions in 1961-62. The University of California had the largest number of foreign students (2,534). Howard University had the highest percentage (16.6) of foreign students to total enrollment, followed by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (12.3), Harvard (7.7), Georgetown University (7.1), and Cornell (6.5). The largest number of foreign students (13,031) were enrolled in Engineering, while the smallest number (1,893) was in Agriculture.

The Cornell distribution of foreign students by country and by college or school is attached.
