FOREIGN STUDENT ENROLLMENT 1968-69

We are pleased to present a summary of the foreign student enrollment at Cornell University for the academic year 1968-69. A total of 1122 students from abroad are enrolled this year, an increase of 54 over last year.

Foreign students, representing 87 countries, make up 8% of the total Cornell student population in Ithaca. Canadian students comprise the largest national group (223) followed by Chinese (129) and Indians (81).

Graduate foreign students number 802, an increase of 57 over 1967-68. Our foreign graduate students make up 23.1% of the University Graduate School enrollment. Graduate level enrollment, including The Graduate School and the Schools of Aerospace Engineering, Business and Public Administration, and Law is 20.2%.

The University has 320 undergraduate foreign students enrolled, a decrease of 3 from last year. They comprise 3.2% of the total undergraduate enrollment. Undergraduate schools and colleges with the highest percentage of foreign students are Hotel Administration 12.4%, Agriculture 4.6%, and Architecture 4.4%.

The distribution of foreign students by country and college and school is attached with a list of the graduate student enrollment by department.

We are also attaching some statistics on the national enrollment of foreign students compiled by the Institute of International Education for 1967-68 and reported in their publication OPEN DOORS.

Total Foreign Students in the United States: 110,315 (a record number)

Countries Represented: 172

The Far East continues to dominate area representation with 37,228 (33.7%), followed by Latin America 21,908 (19.9%) and Europe 15,556 (14.1%)

Where They Studied: at 1,827 institutions (30 more than previous year), with 55% of the total number of students concentrated in 66 colleges and universities, each of which reported an enrollment of 400 or more foreign students.

Three Universities with the greatest number of foreign students:

New York University 3,340 (8.1% of total enrollment)

University of California, Berkeley 2,790 (9.7% of total enrollment)

Columbia University 2,590 (10.2% of total enrollment)

Cornell ranked 13th in percentage of foreign students to total enrollment with 7.5%
