FOREIGN STUDENT ENROLLMENT
1975-76

We are pleased to present a summary of Cornell's foreign student enrollment for the academic year 1975-76. A total of 1177 students from abroad are enrolled this year, an increase of 46 (4.1%) over last year.

Foreign students, representing 95 countries, make up 7.1% of the total Cornell student population in Ithaca. Canadian students (135) and Chinese students (135) comprise the largest national groups, followed by Indians (68).

Graduate foreign students number 846, an increase of 32 over 1974-75. Our foreign graduate students make up 21.6% of the University Graduate School enrollment. Graduate level enrollment, including the Graduate School and the Schools of Business and Public Administration, Law, and the College of Veterinary Medicine is 17.4%.

The University has 331 undergraduate foreign students enrolled, an increase of 14 over last year. They comprise 2.8% of the total undergraduate enrollment. Undergraduate schools and colleges with the highest percentage of foreign students are Hotel Administration 12.7%, Architecture 5.4%, and Engineering 2.9%.

The distribution of foreign students by country, college and school is attached.
