FOREIGN STUDENT ENROLLMENT  
1976-77

We are pleased to present a summary of Cornell's foreign student enrollment for the academic year 1976-77. A total of 1137 students from abroad are enrolled this year, a decrease of 40 (3.4%) from last year.

Foreign Students, representing 96 countries, make up 6.8% of the total Cornell student population in Ithaca. Chinese students (134) and Canadian students (126) comprise the largest national groups, followed by Indians (62).

Graduate foreign students number 819, a decrease of 27 (3.2%) from 1975-76. Our foreign graduate students make up 21.8% of the University Graduate School enrollment. Graduate level enrollment, including the Graduate School and the Schools of Business and Public Administration, Law, and the College of Veterinary Medicine is 17.3%.

The University has 318 undergraduate foreign students enrolled, a decrease of 13 (3.9%) from last year. They comprise 2.7% of the total undergraduate enrollment. Undergraduate schools and colleges with the highest percentage of foreign students are Hotel Administration 11.1%, Architecture 7.2%, and Engineering 2.9%.

We also have 21 foreign students enrolled in the newly-established Intensive English Program conducted by the Department of Modern Languages and Linguistics.

The distribution of foreign students by country, college and school is attached.
