FOREIGN STUDENT ENROLLMENT  
1977-78

We are pleased to present a summary of Cornell's foreign student enrollment for the academic year 1977-78.

A total of 1074 students from abroad are enrolled this year, a decrease of 63 (5.5%) from last year.

Foreign students, representing 92 countries, make up 6.5% of the total Cornell student population in Ithaca. Chinese students (138), and Canadian students (125) comprise the largest national groups, followed by Indians (60).

Graduate foreign students number 768, a decrease of 51 (6.2%) from 1976-77. Our foreign graduate students make up 20.5% of the University Graduate School enrollment. Graduate level enrollment, including the Graduate School and the Schools of Business and Public Administration, Law, and the College of Veterinary Medicine is 16.5%.

The University has 306 undergraduate foreign students enrolled, a decrease of 12 (3.8%) from last year. They comprise 2.6% of the total undergraduate enrollment. Undergraduate schools and colleges with the highest percentage of foreign students are Hotel Administration 10.4%, Architecture 7.7%, and Engineering 3.7%.

We also have 25 foreign students enrolled in the Intensive English Program conducted by the Department of Modern Languages and Linguistics.

The distribution of foreign students by country, college and school is attached.
