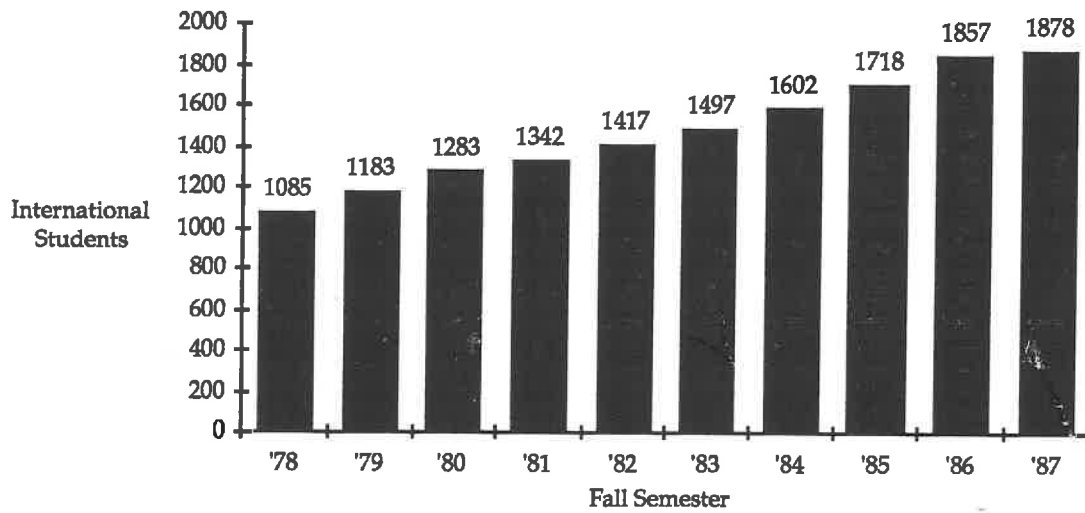

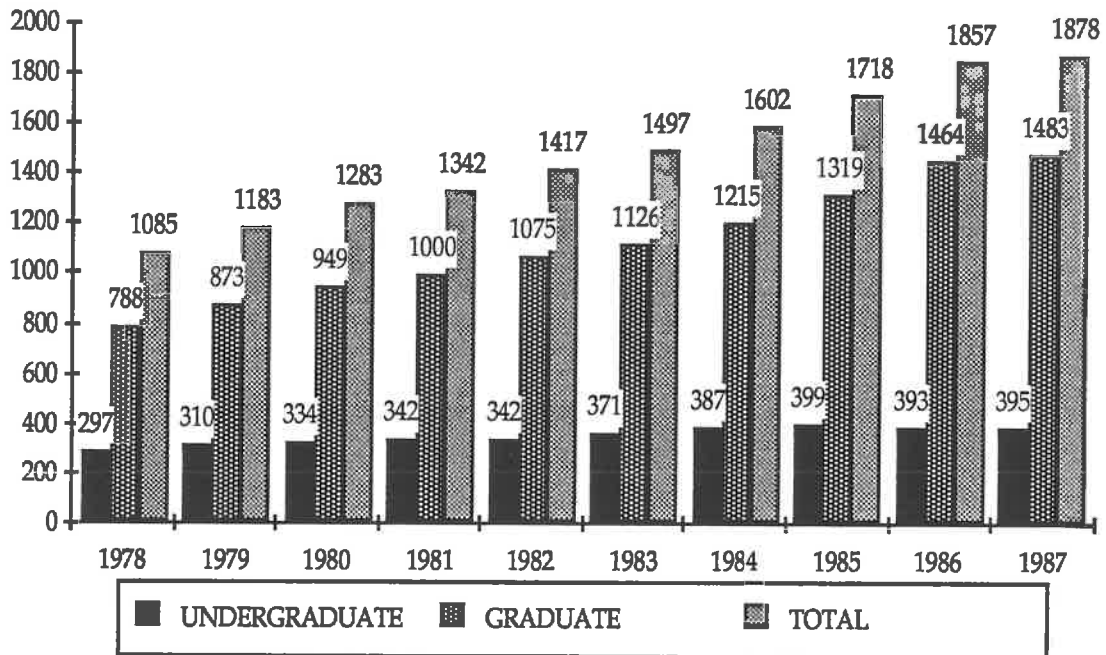
International Student Enrollment  
(1978 to 1987)



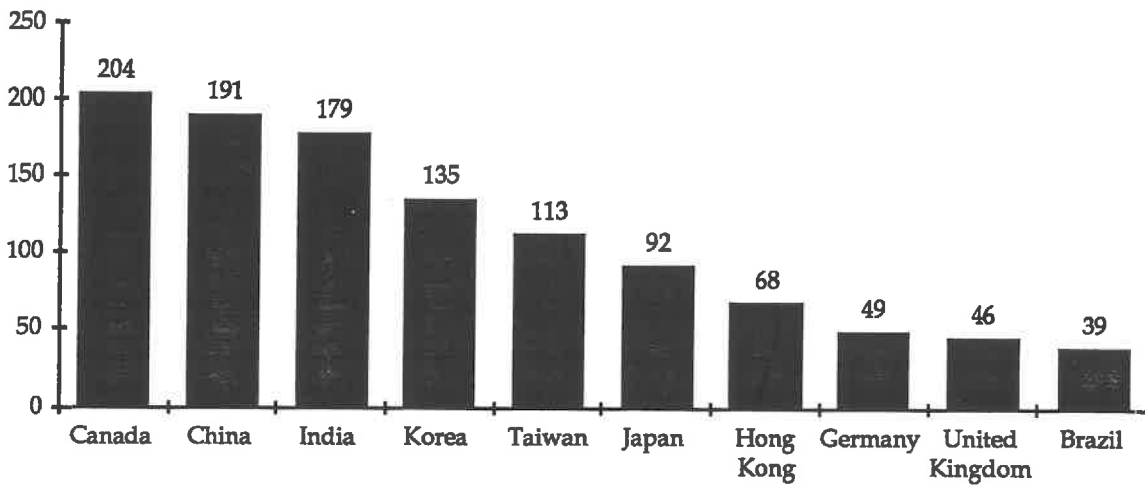

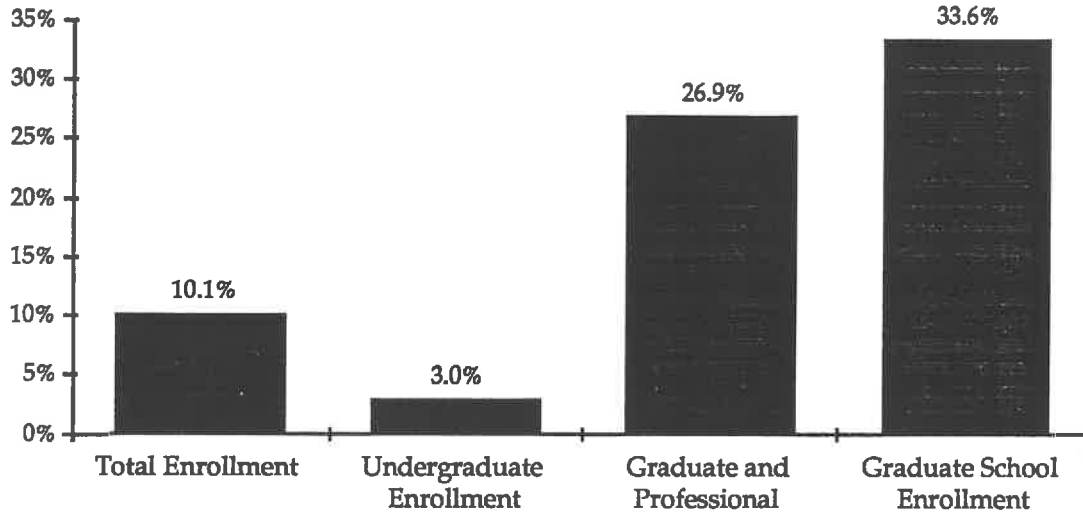
## Graduate Level-Undergraduate Enrollment

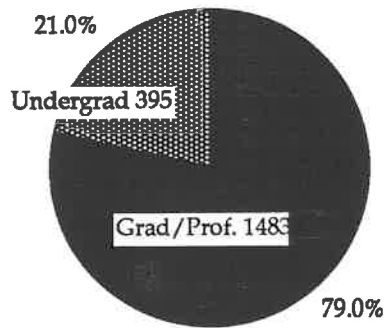

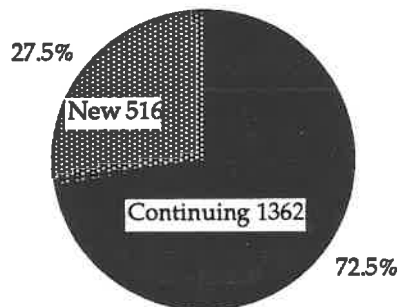
