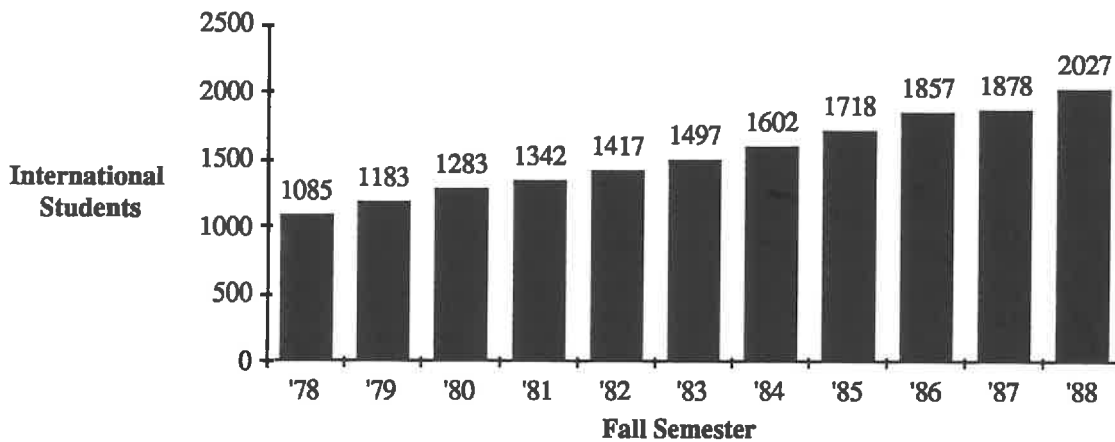

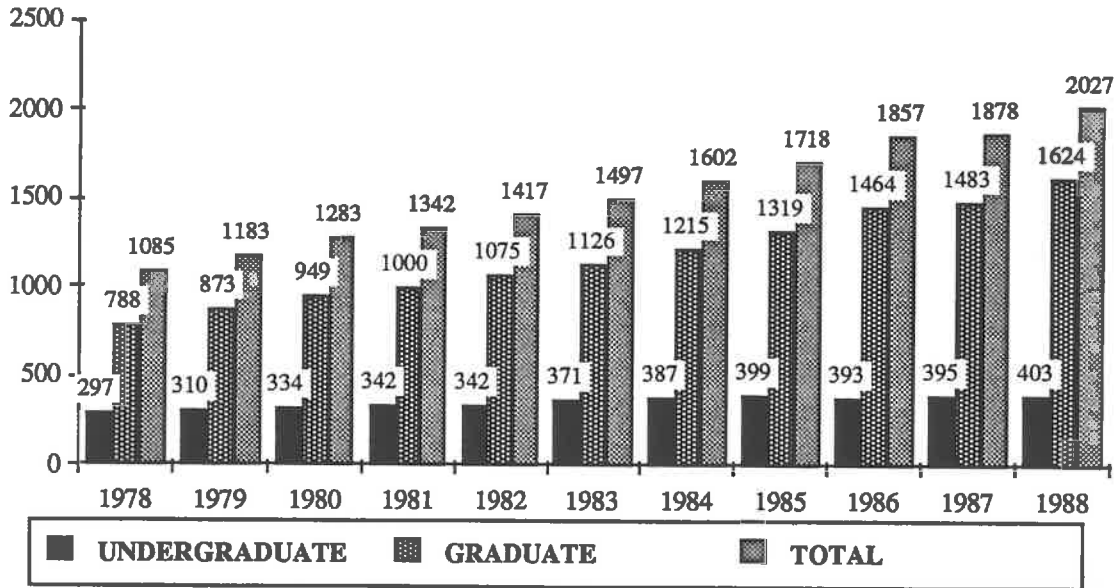
**International Student Enrollment  
(1978 to 1988)**



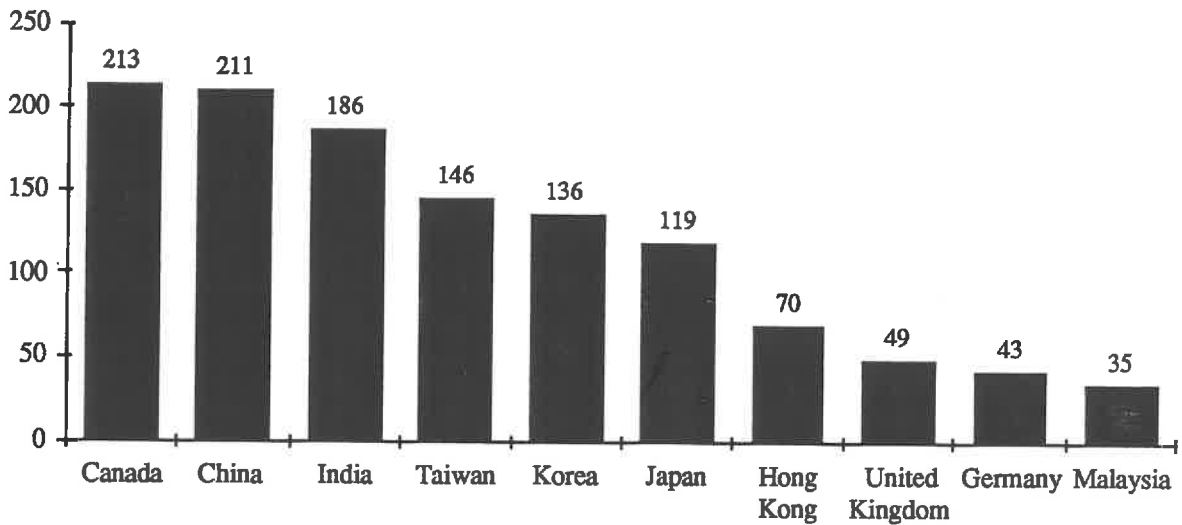

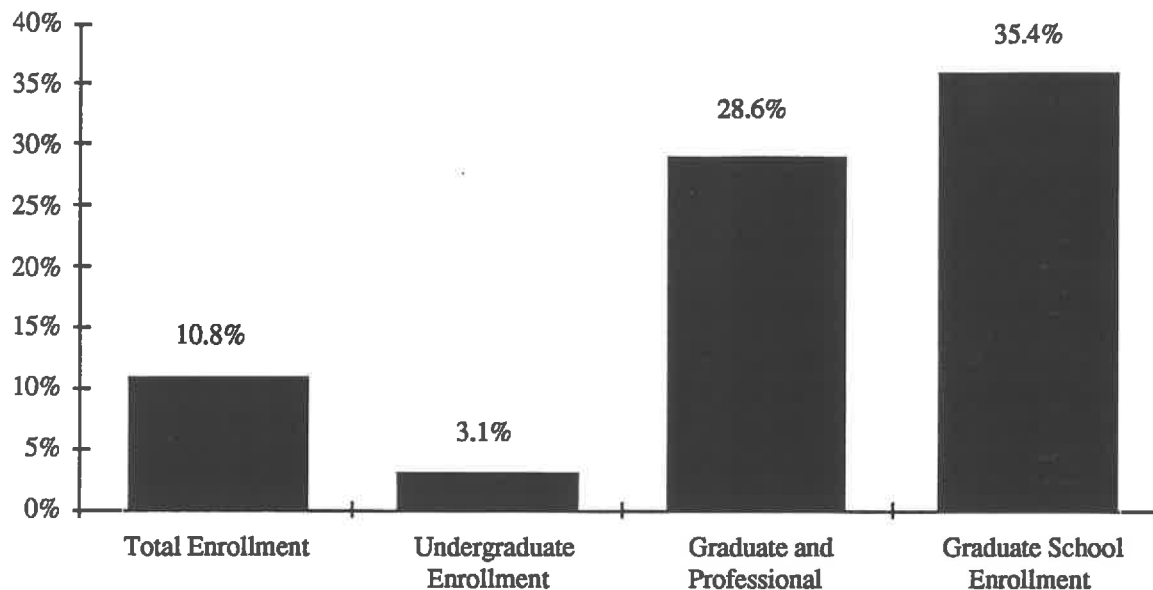
## Graduate Level-Undergraduate Enrollment

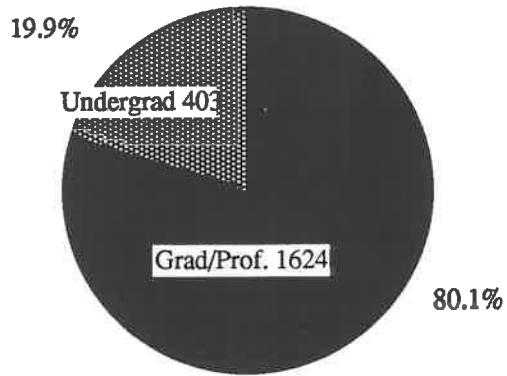

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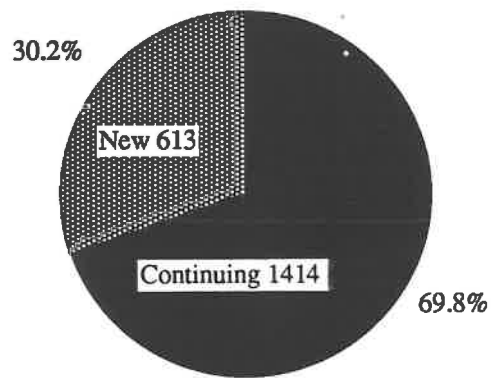
