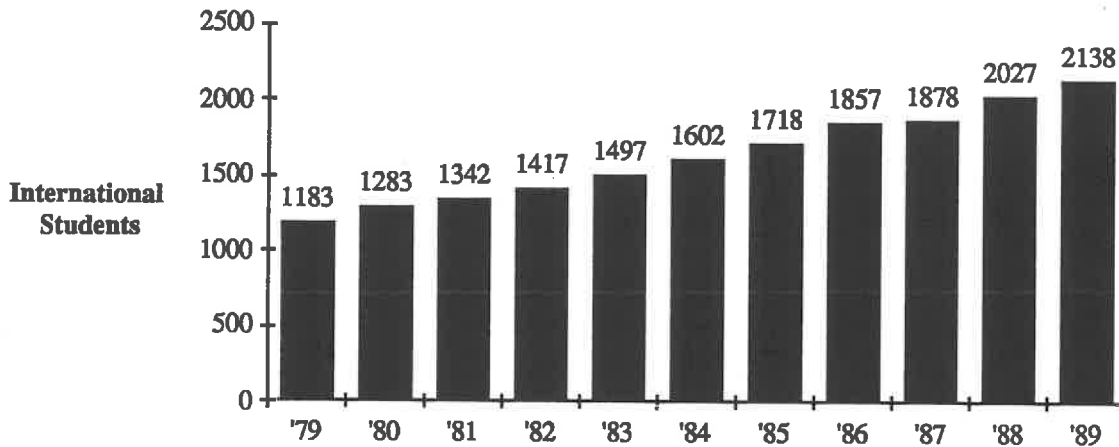

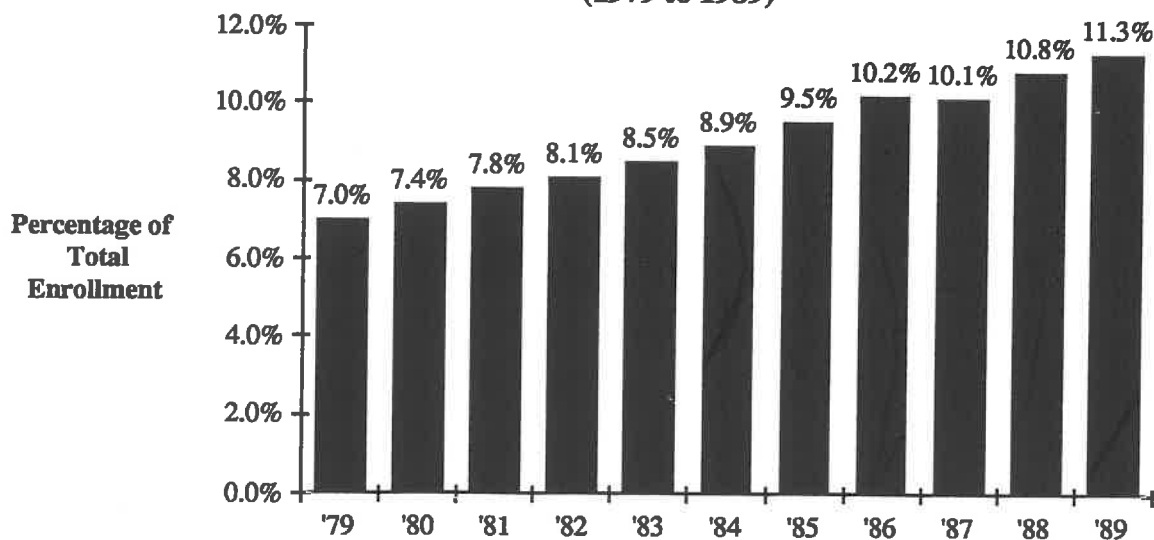

(1979 to 1989)**



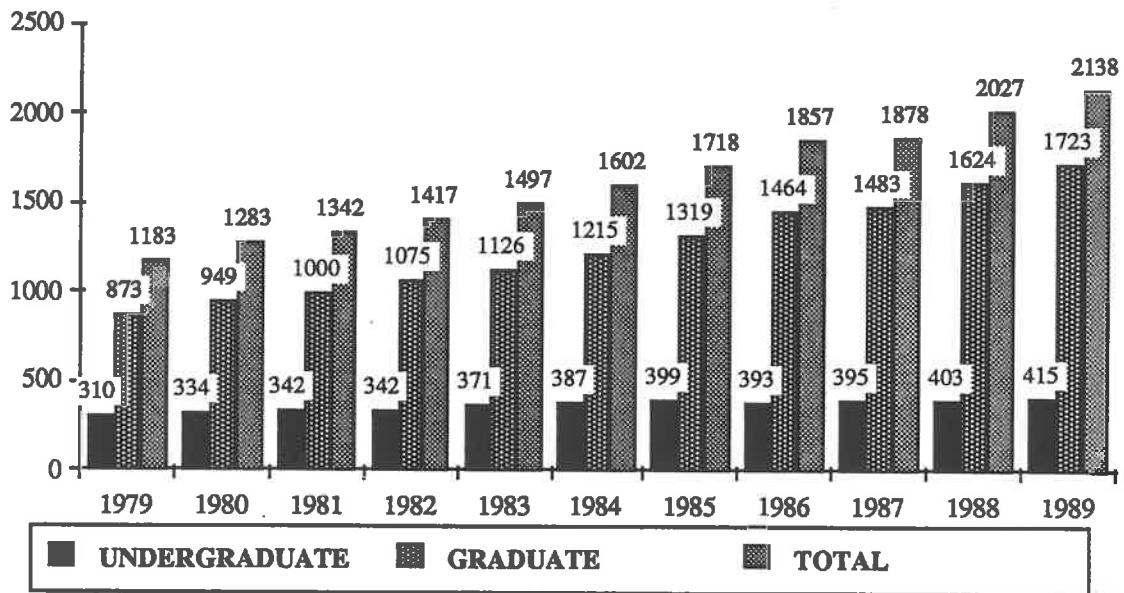
**Percentage of Total Enrollment - International Students
(1979 to 1989)**



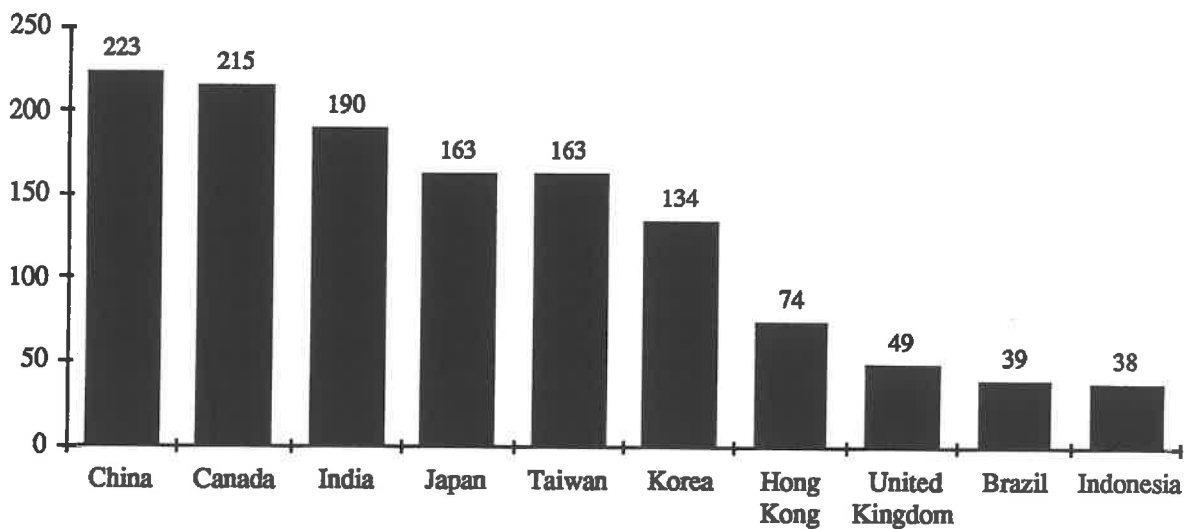

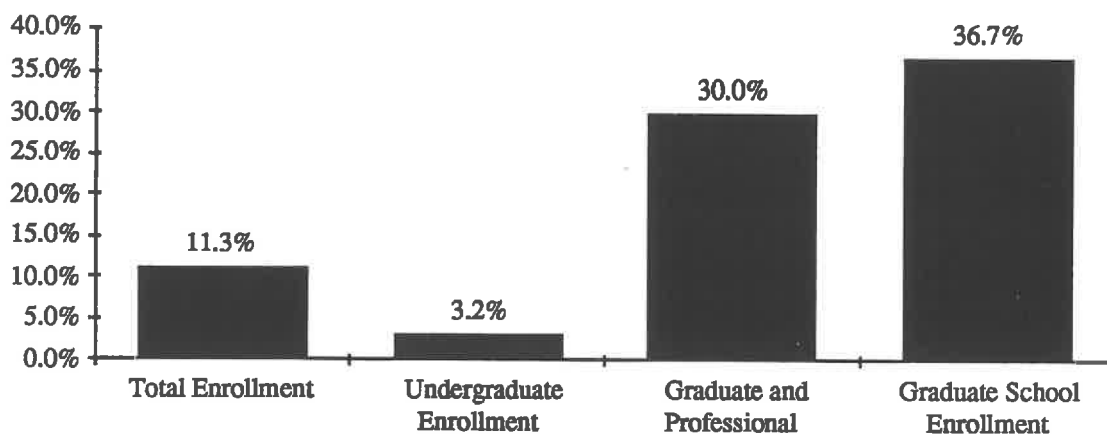
Graduate Level-Undergraduate Enrollment

PERCENTAGE OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IN UNDERGRADUATE DIVISIONS

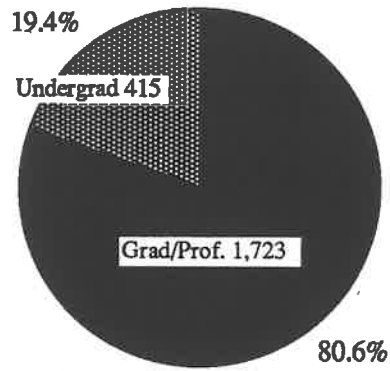

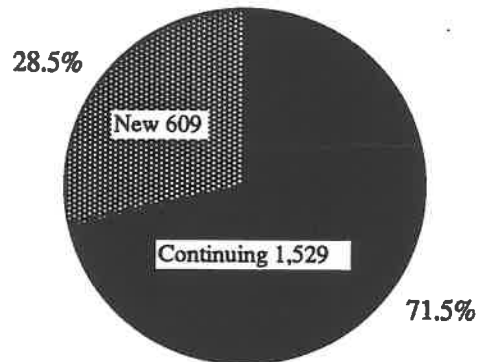

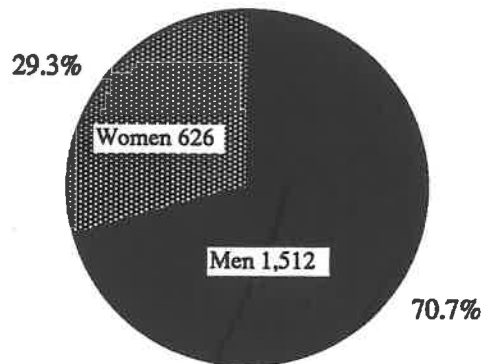
Graduate & Professional vs. Undergraduate International Students
