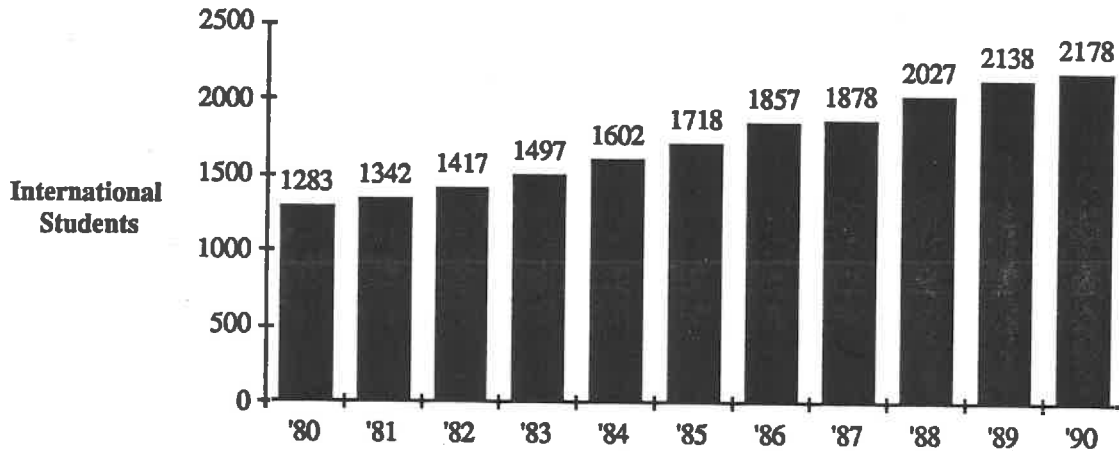

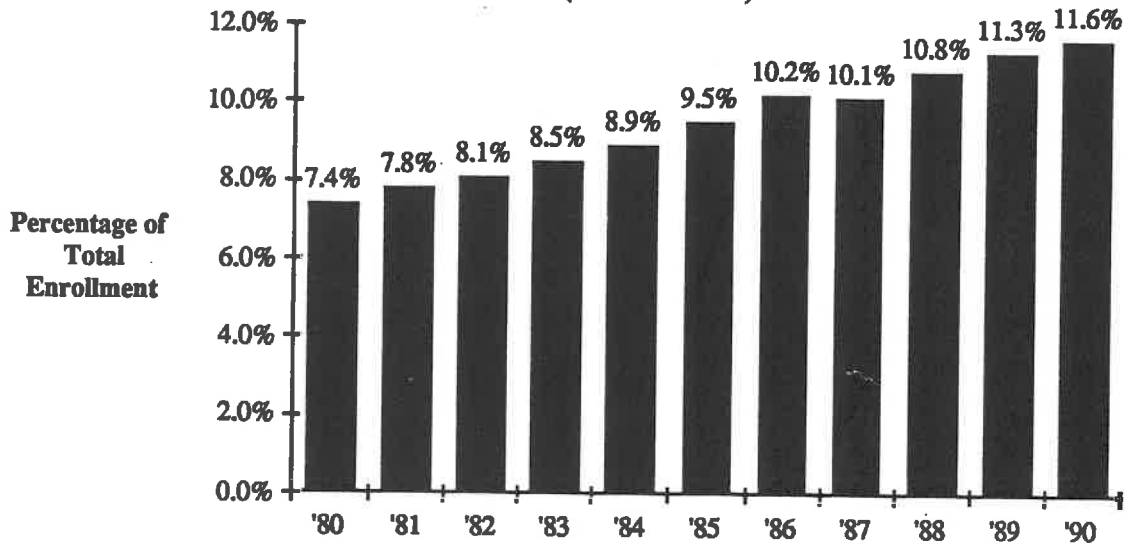

(1980 to 1990)**



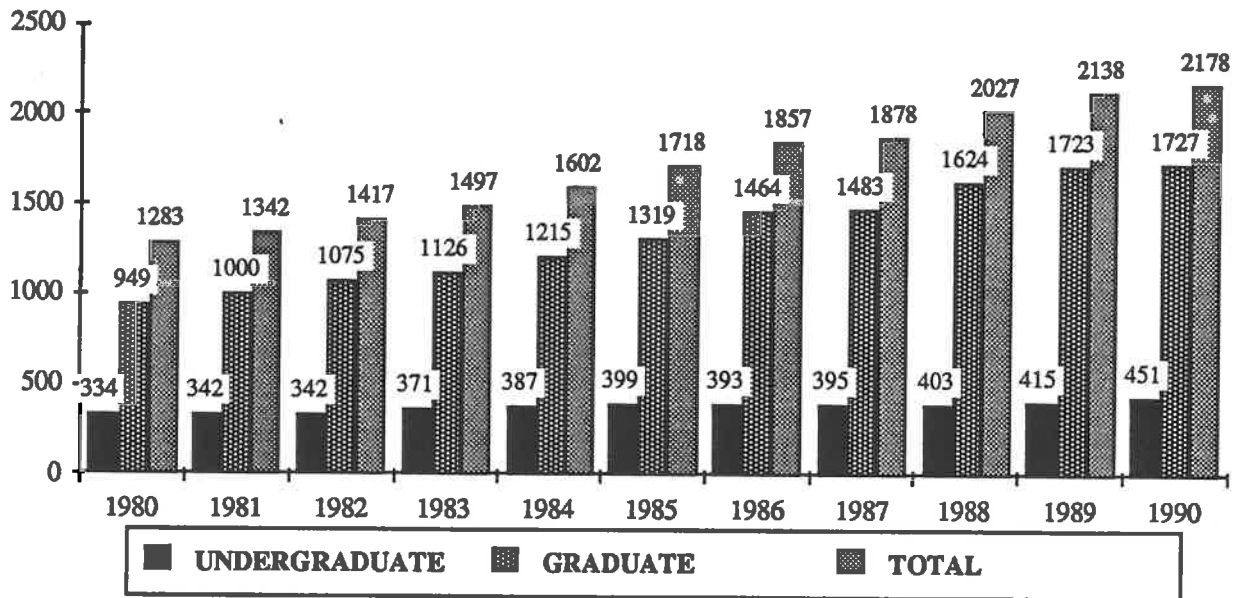
**Percentage of Total Enrollment - International Students  
(1980 to 1990)**



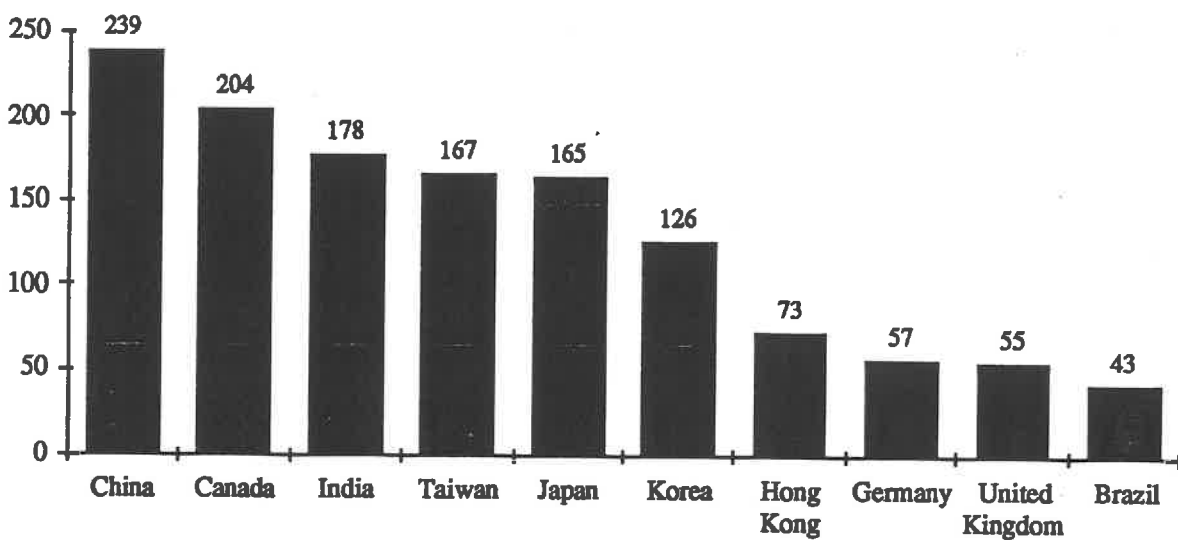

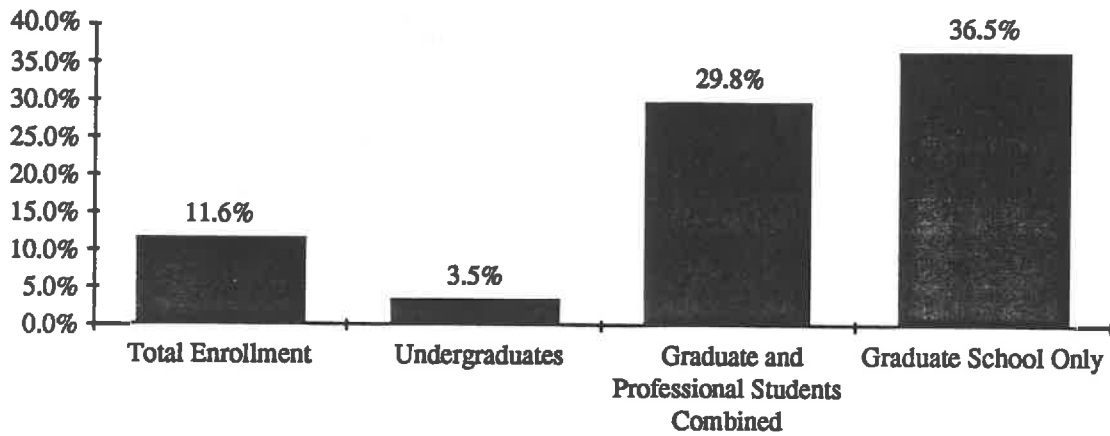
## Graduate Level-Undergraduate Enrollment

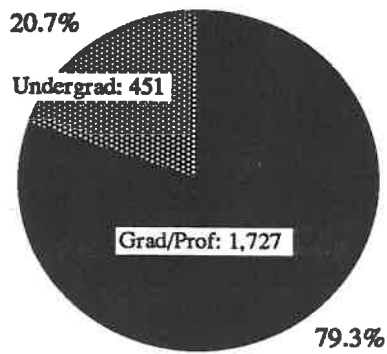

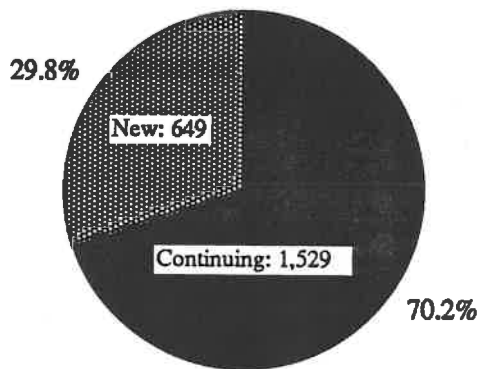
### National ranking 1989-90 Student Enrollment

Cornell ranked 26th in the number of enrolled foreign nationals and 19th in the percentage of total campus enrollment.

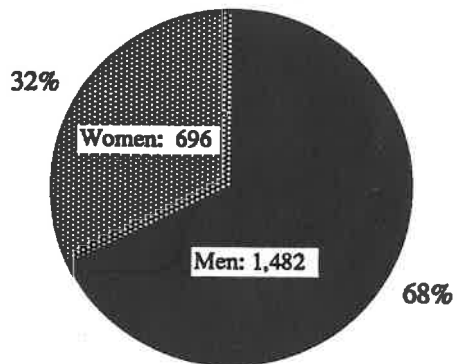
## Graduate & Professional vs. Undergraduate International Students
