

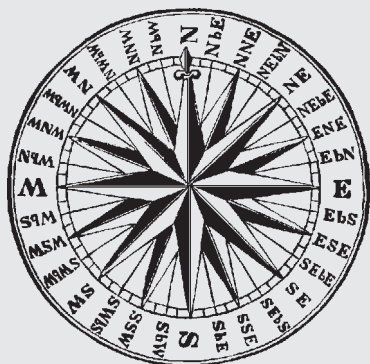

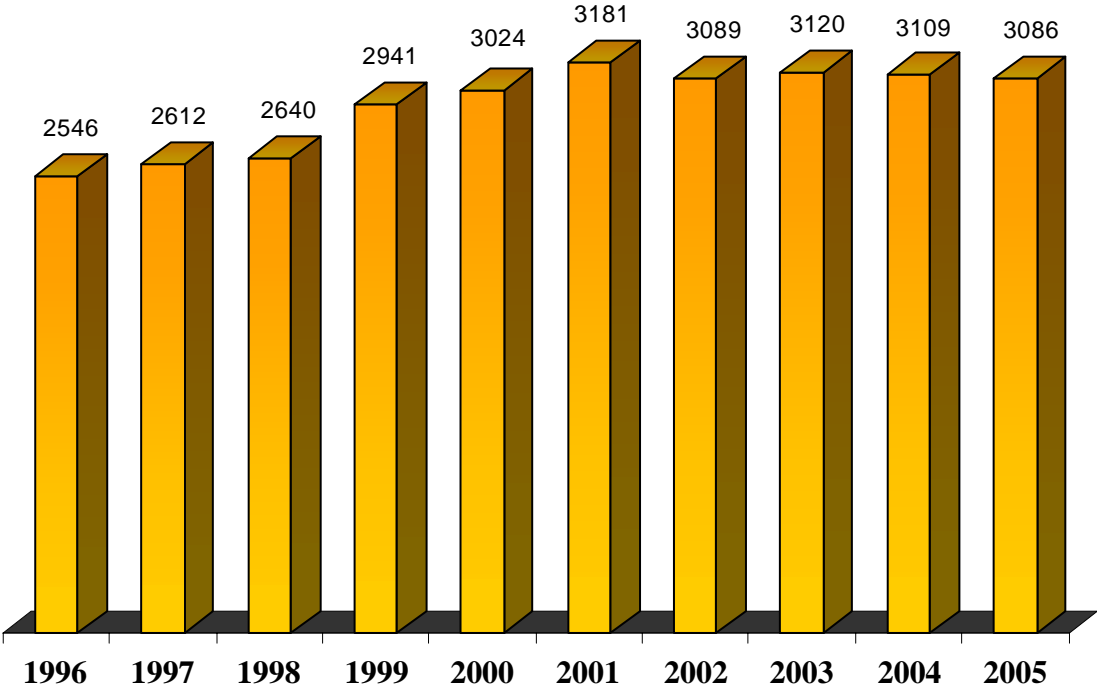

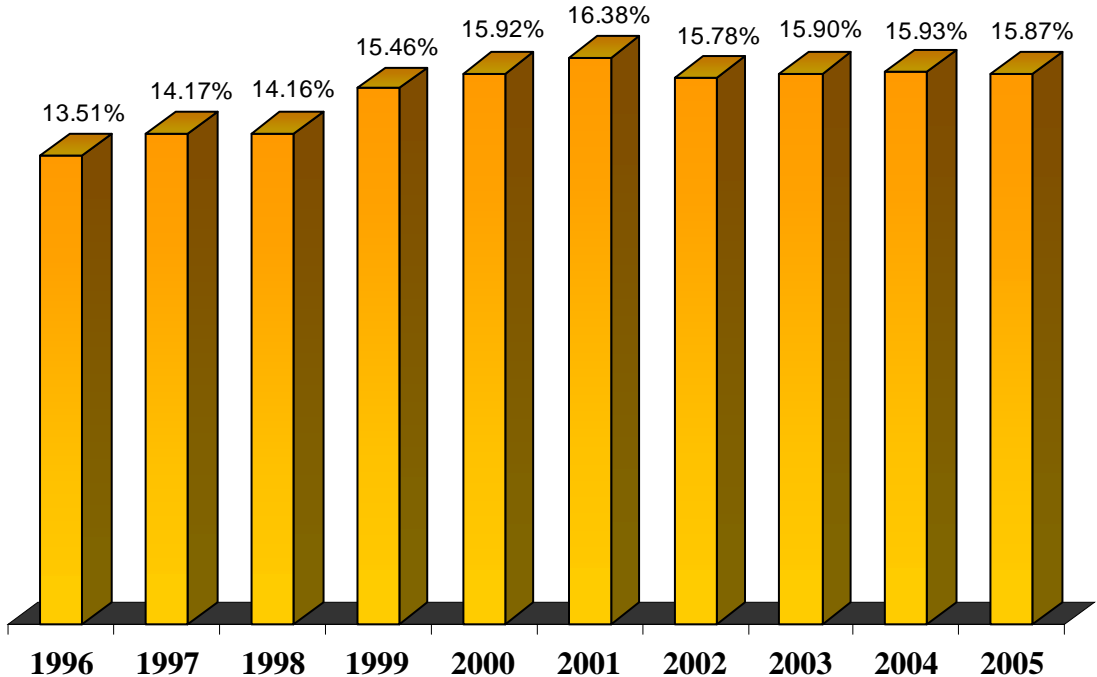


International Students

International Students as a Percentage of Total Cornell Enrollment 1996-2005

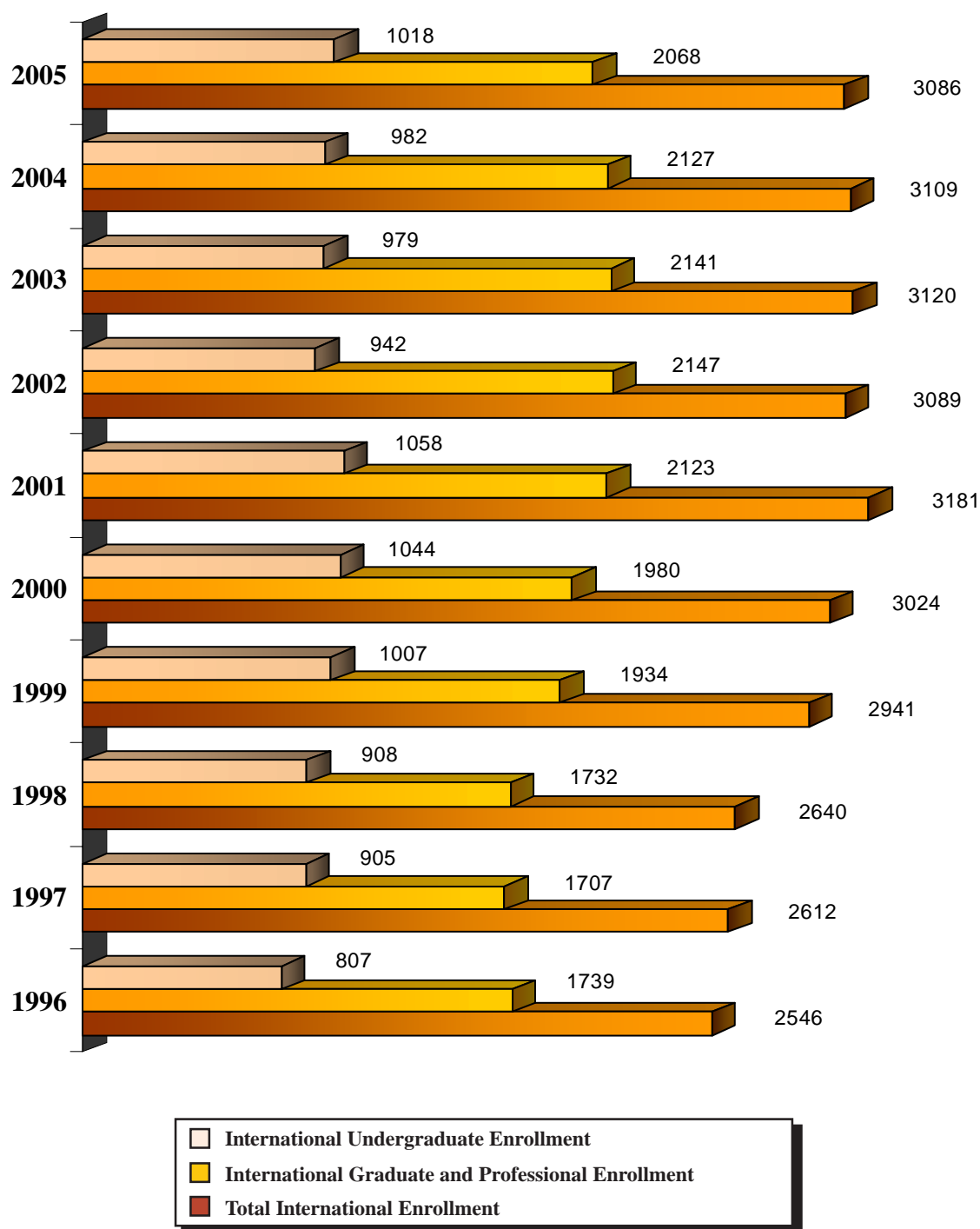

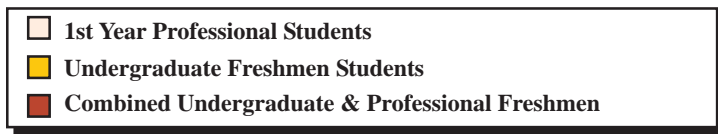
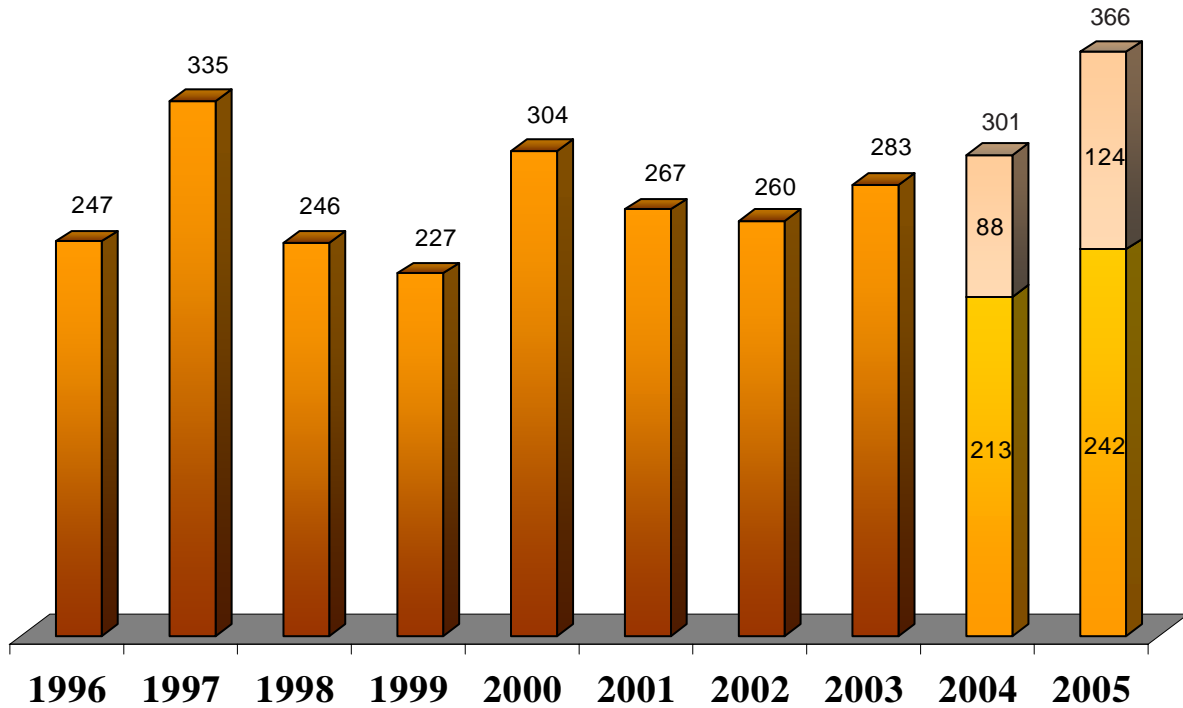

International Student Enrollment Undergraduate, Graduate and Professional 1996–2005

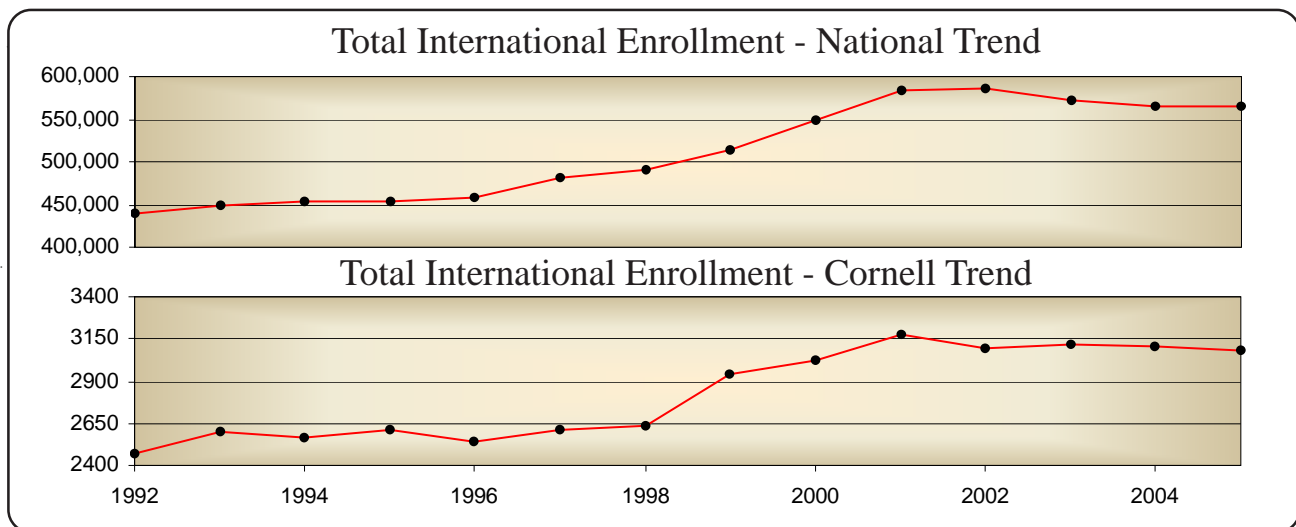
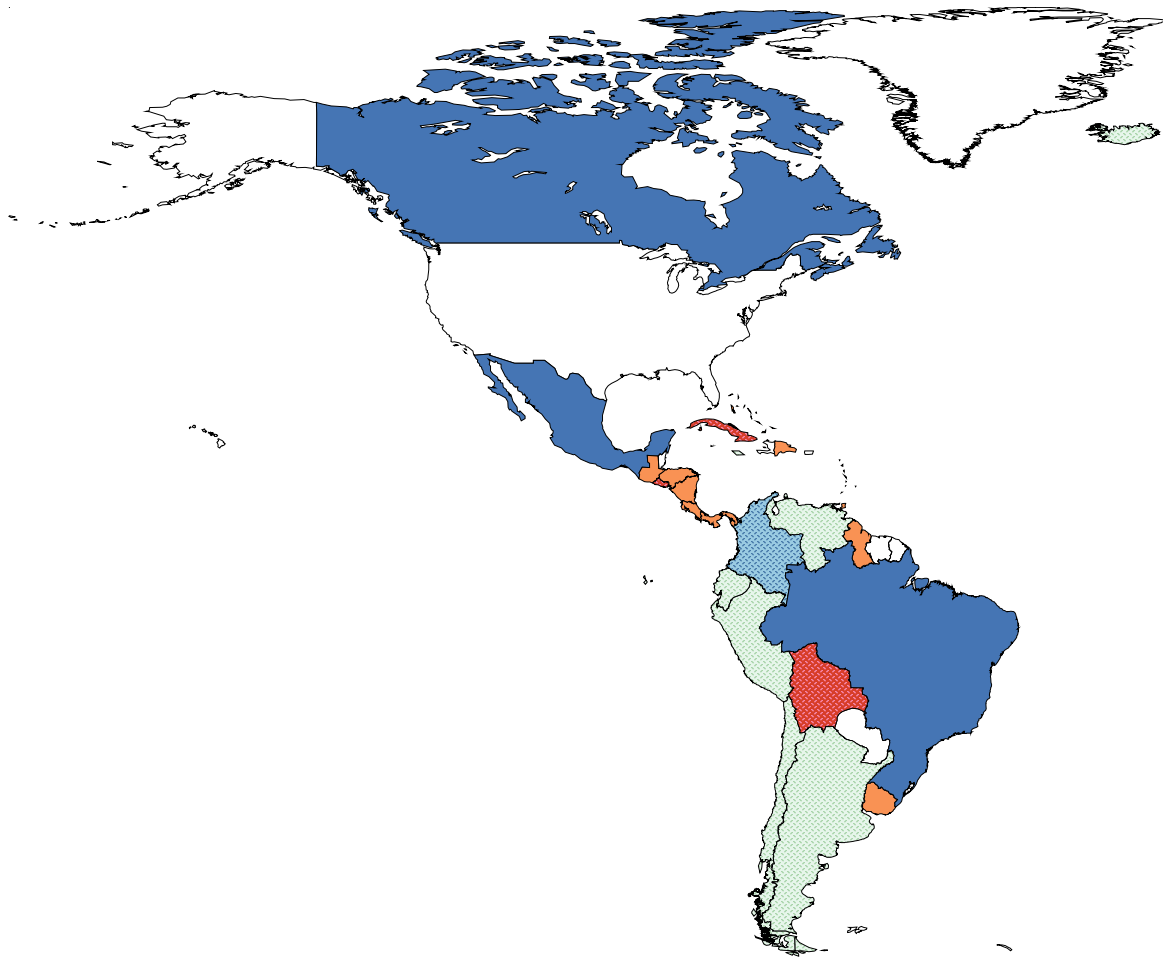


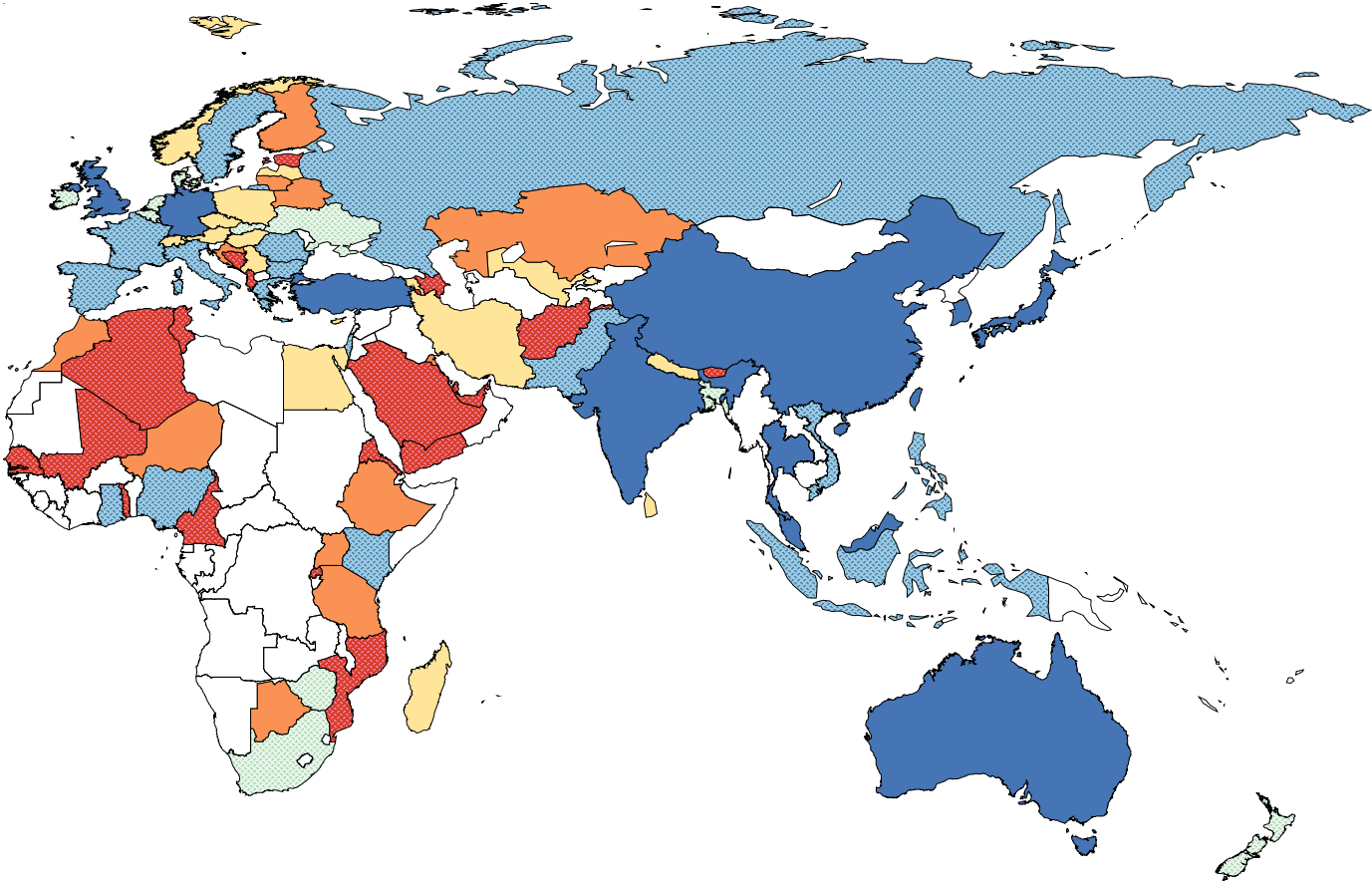
International Freshmen & Transfer Students 1996-2005

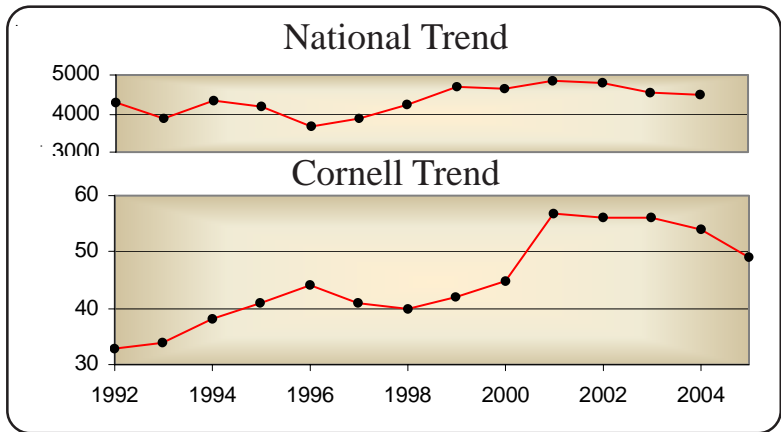

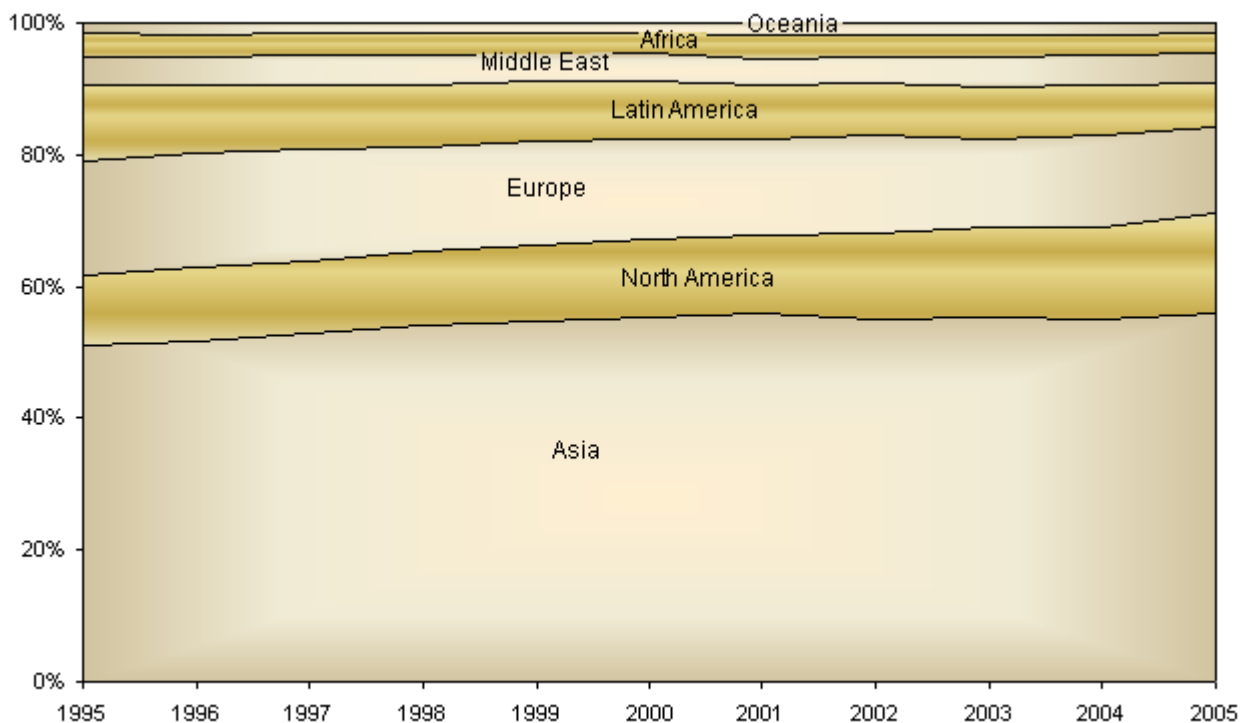

Together, the 2170 students from these 10 countries account for 70.3% of the total international student population at Cornell, and 11.2% of Cornell's total enrollment.

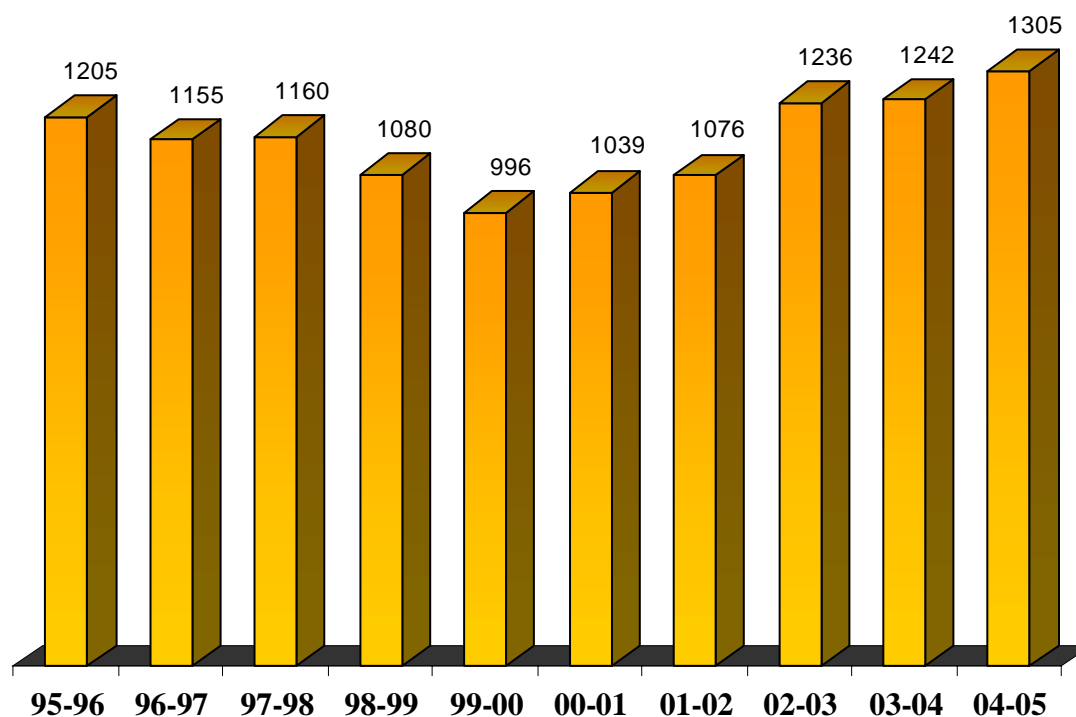
Regional Enrollment Trends 1996-2005



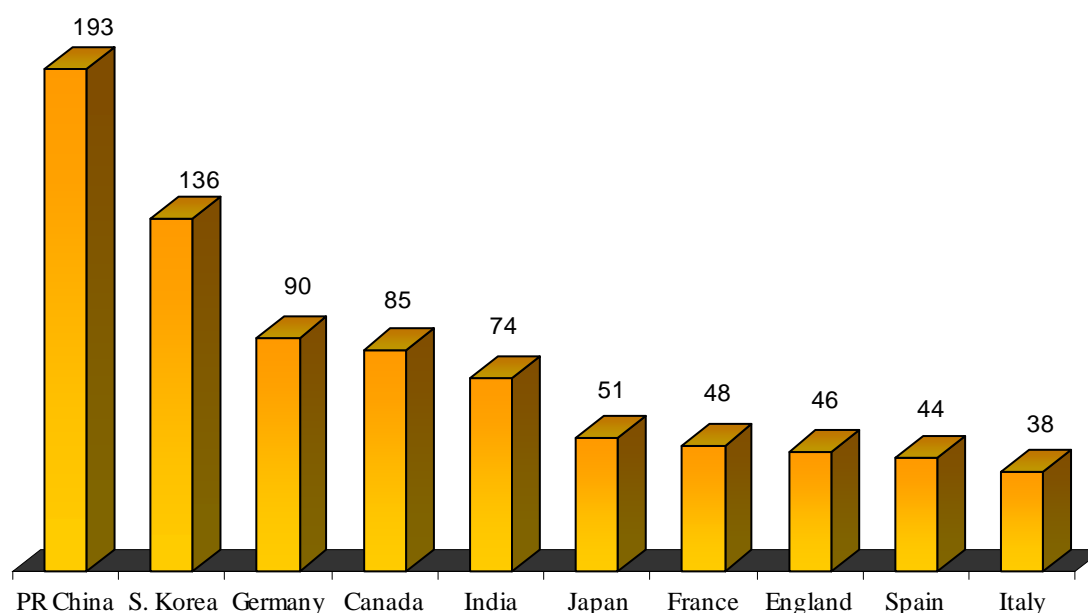
