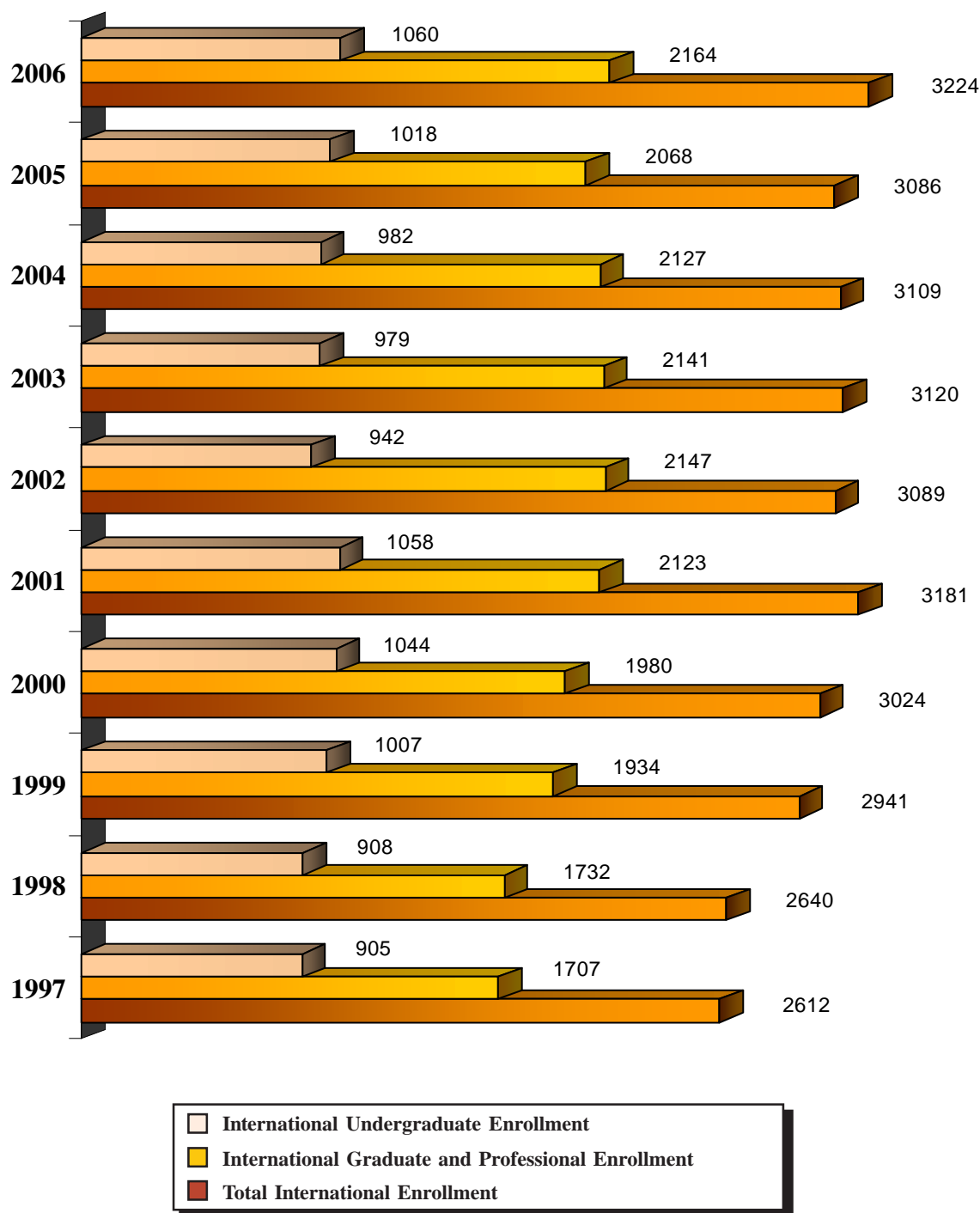
# International Students as a Percentage of Total Cornell Enrollment



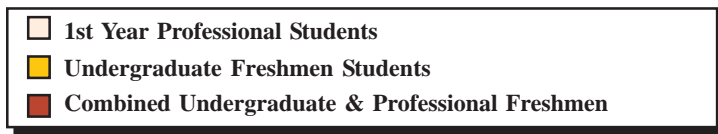
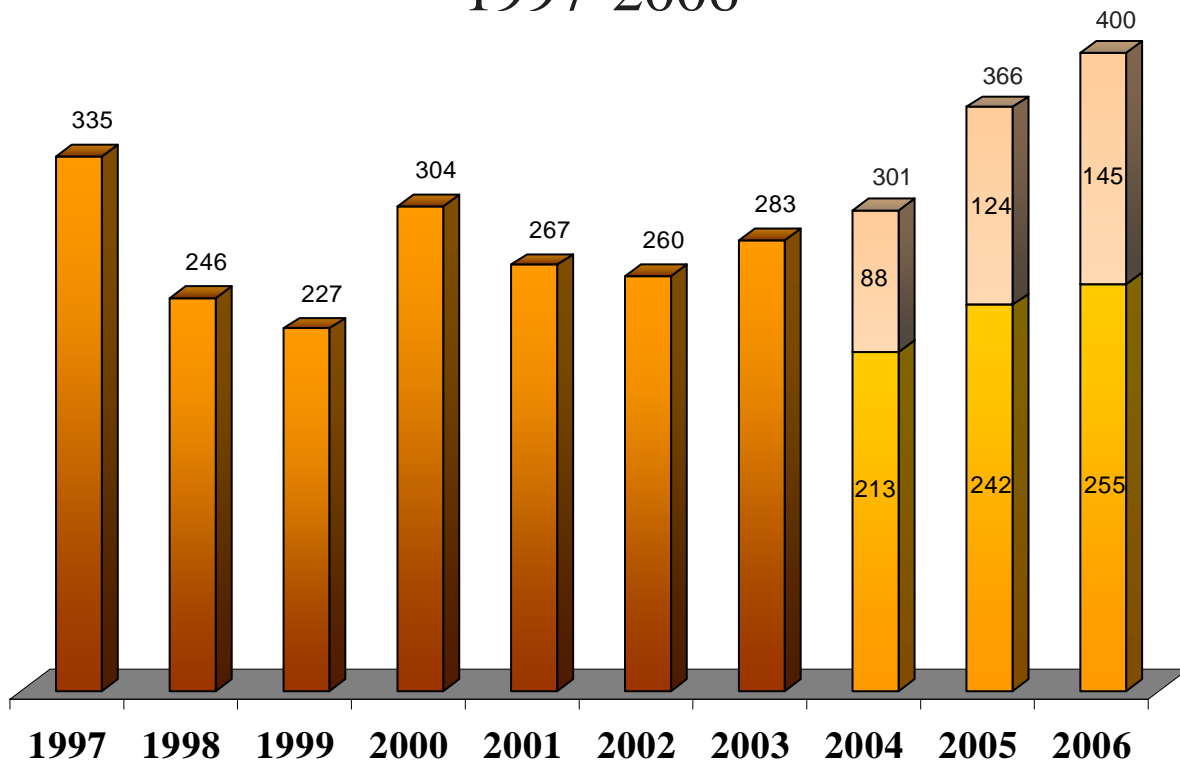

## International Student Enrollment Undergraduate, Graduate and Professional 1997–2006



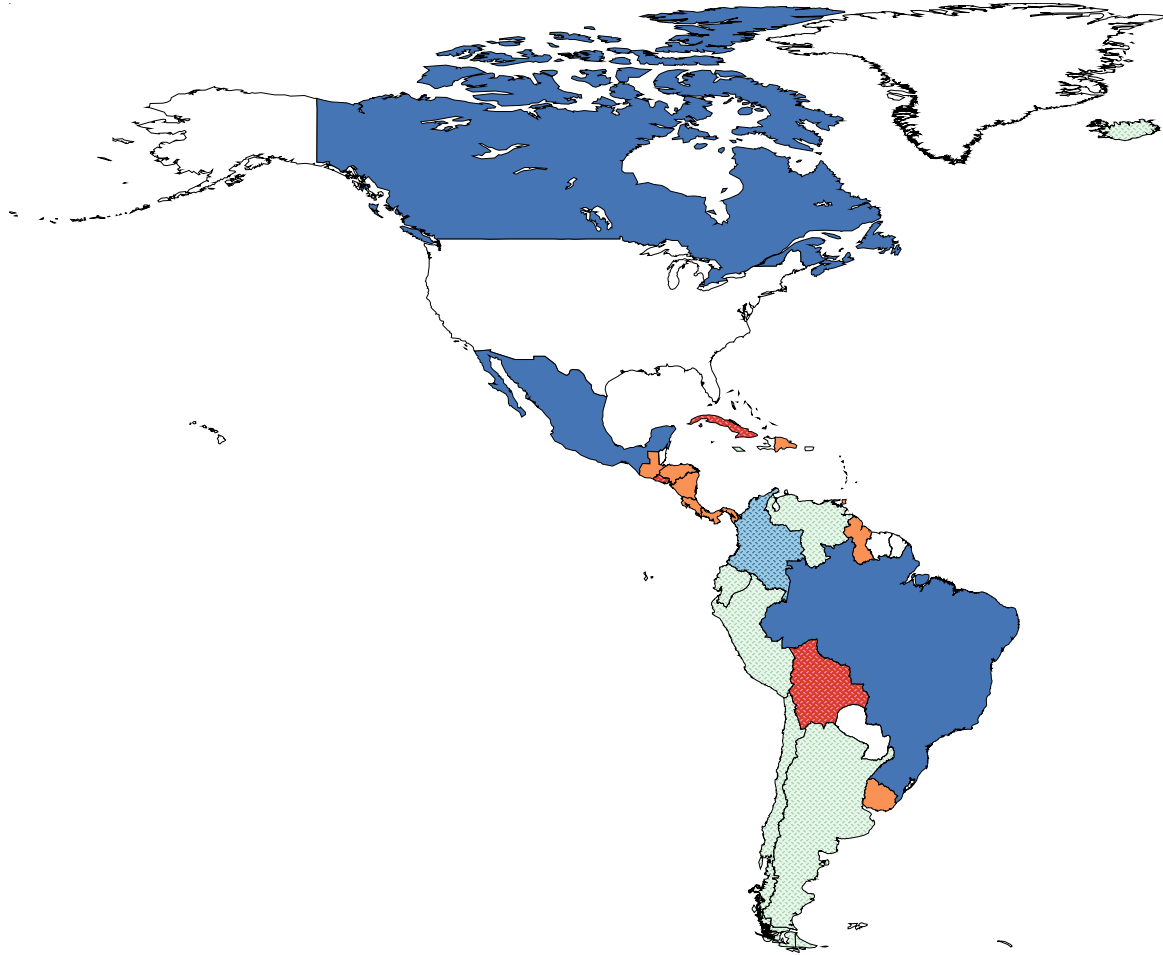

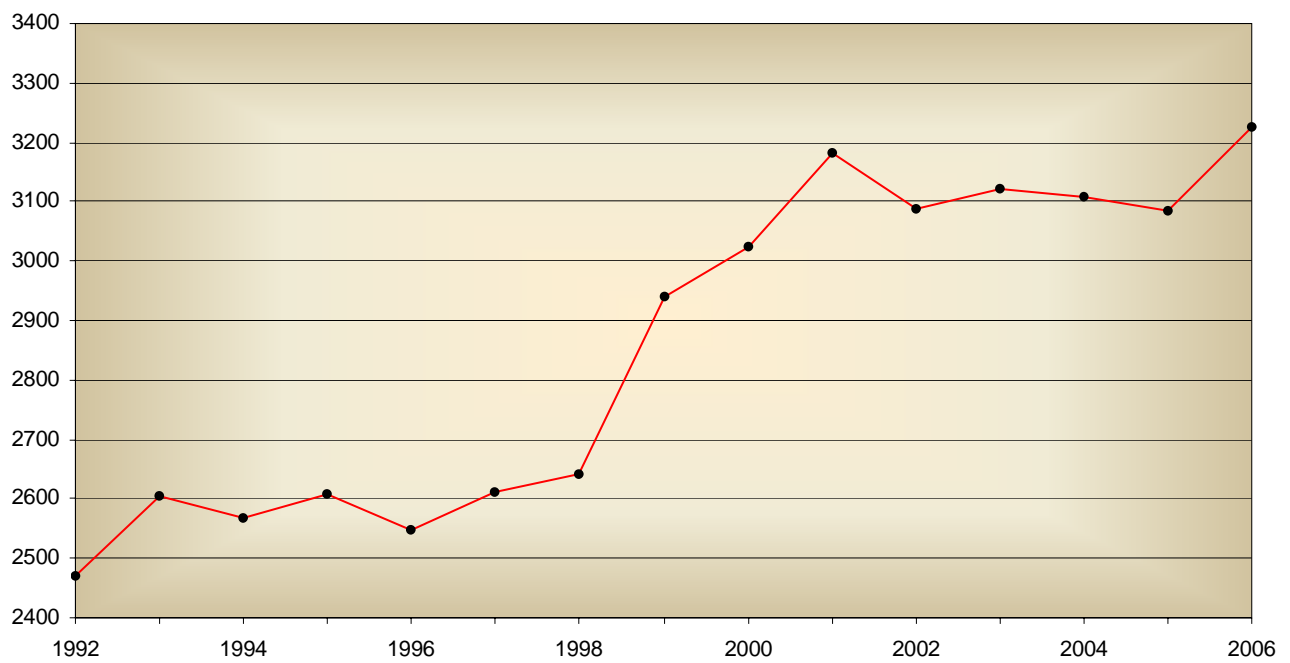

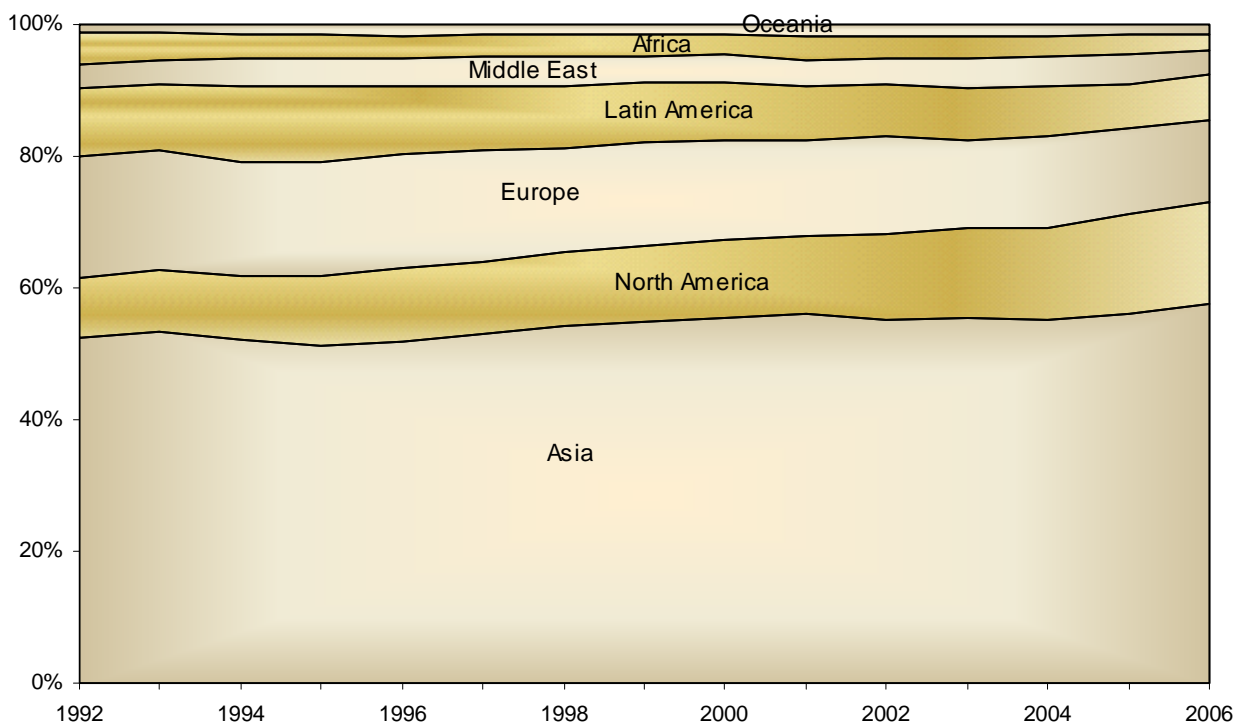

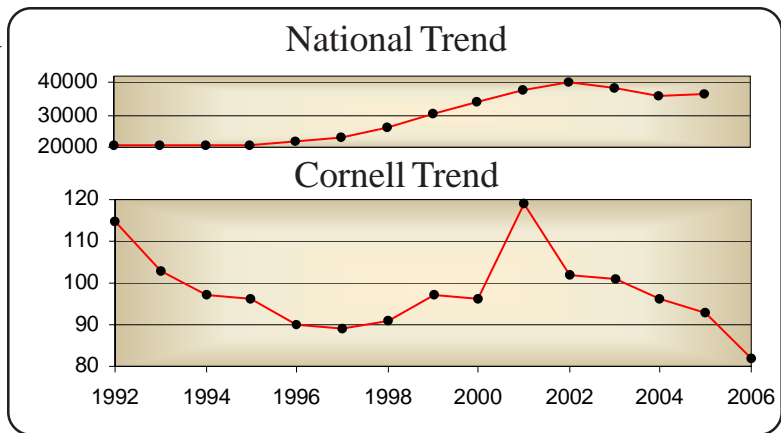
## Regional Enrollment Trends 1992-2006



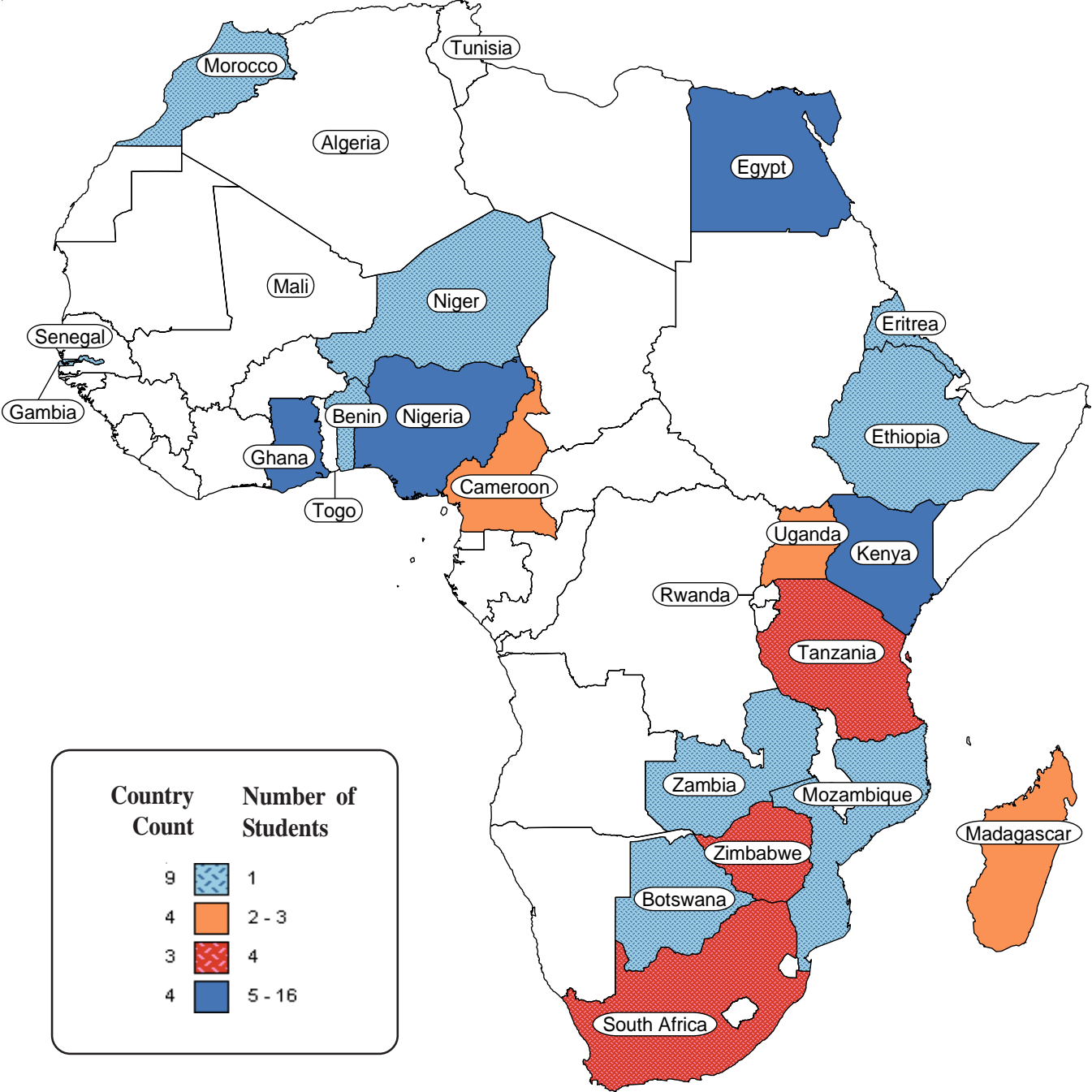

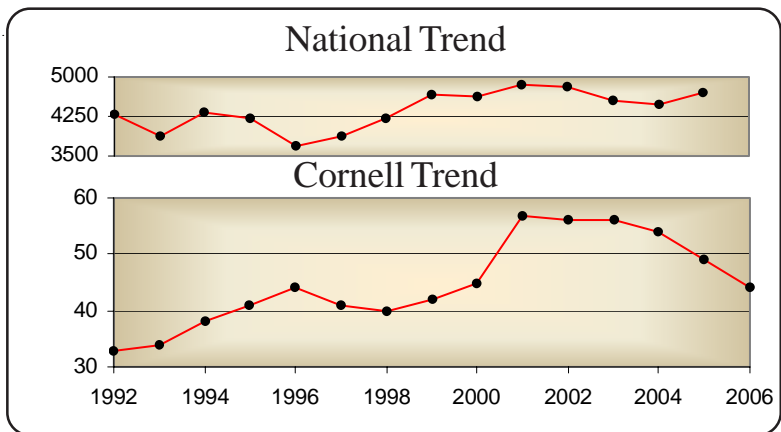

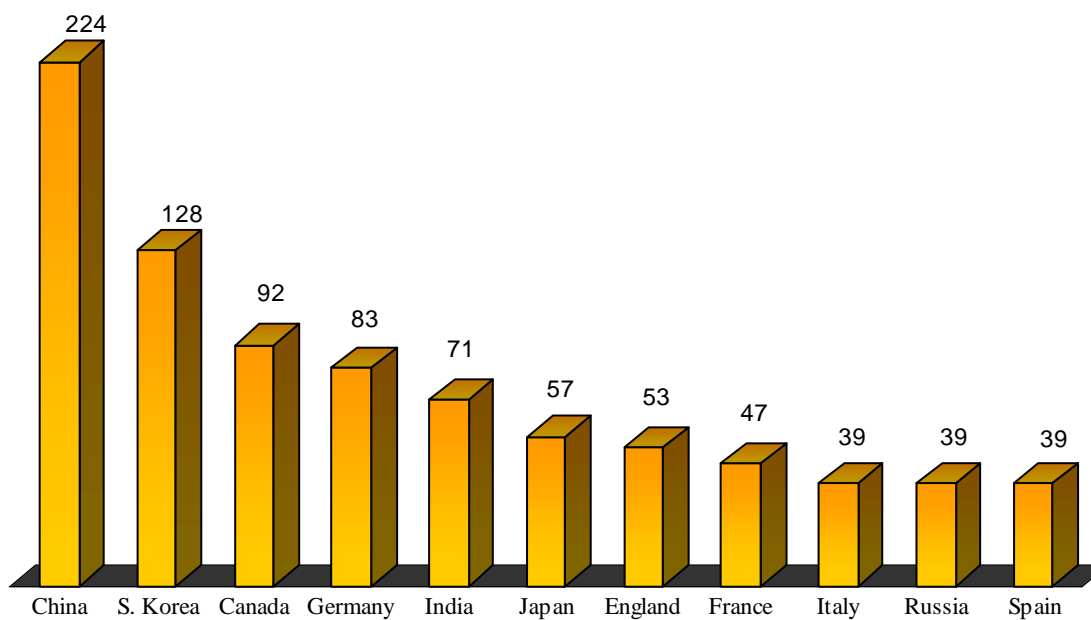
