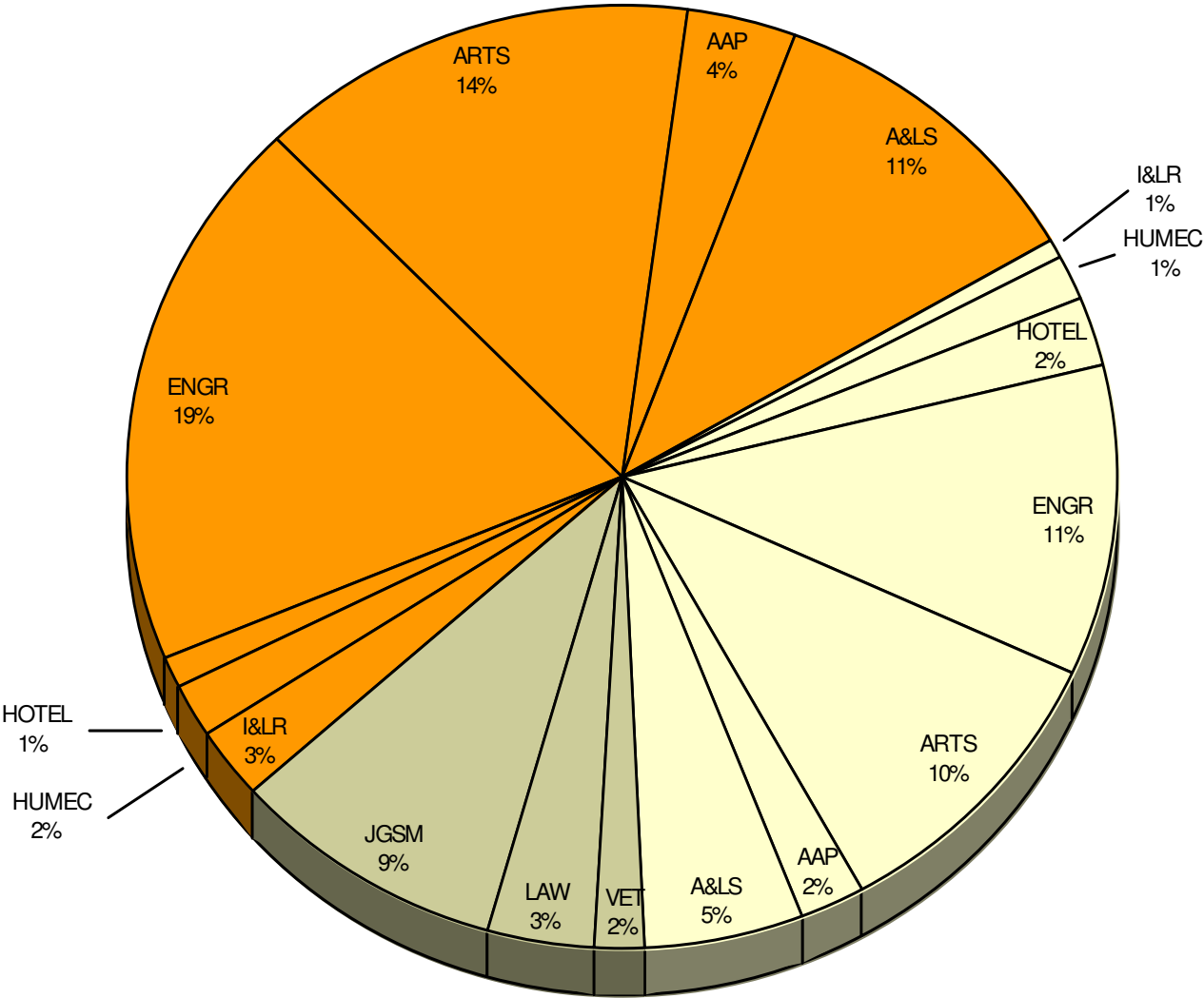
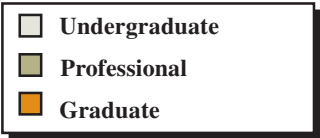
International Students as a Percentage of Total Cornell Enrollment



Cornell University Enrollment by College, Fall 2007

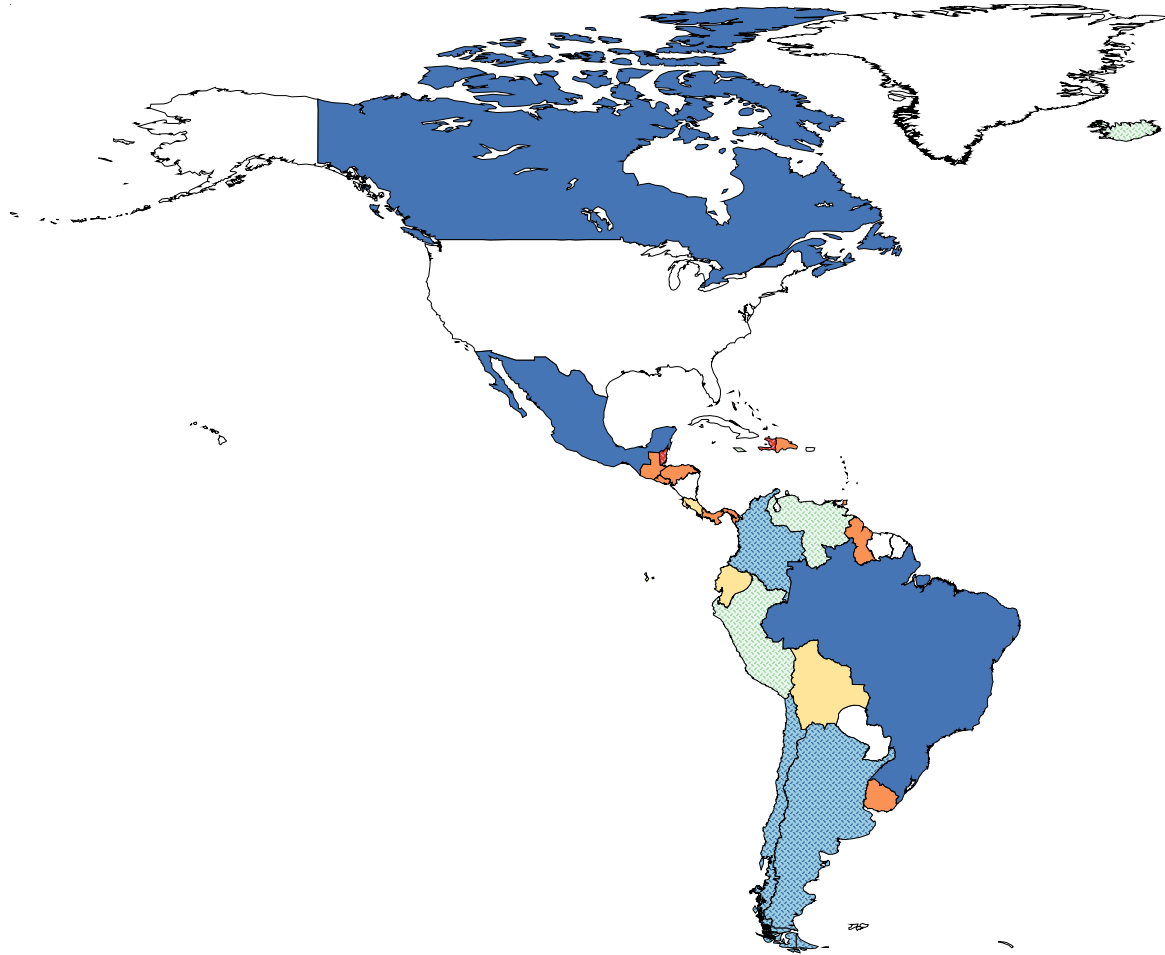

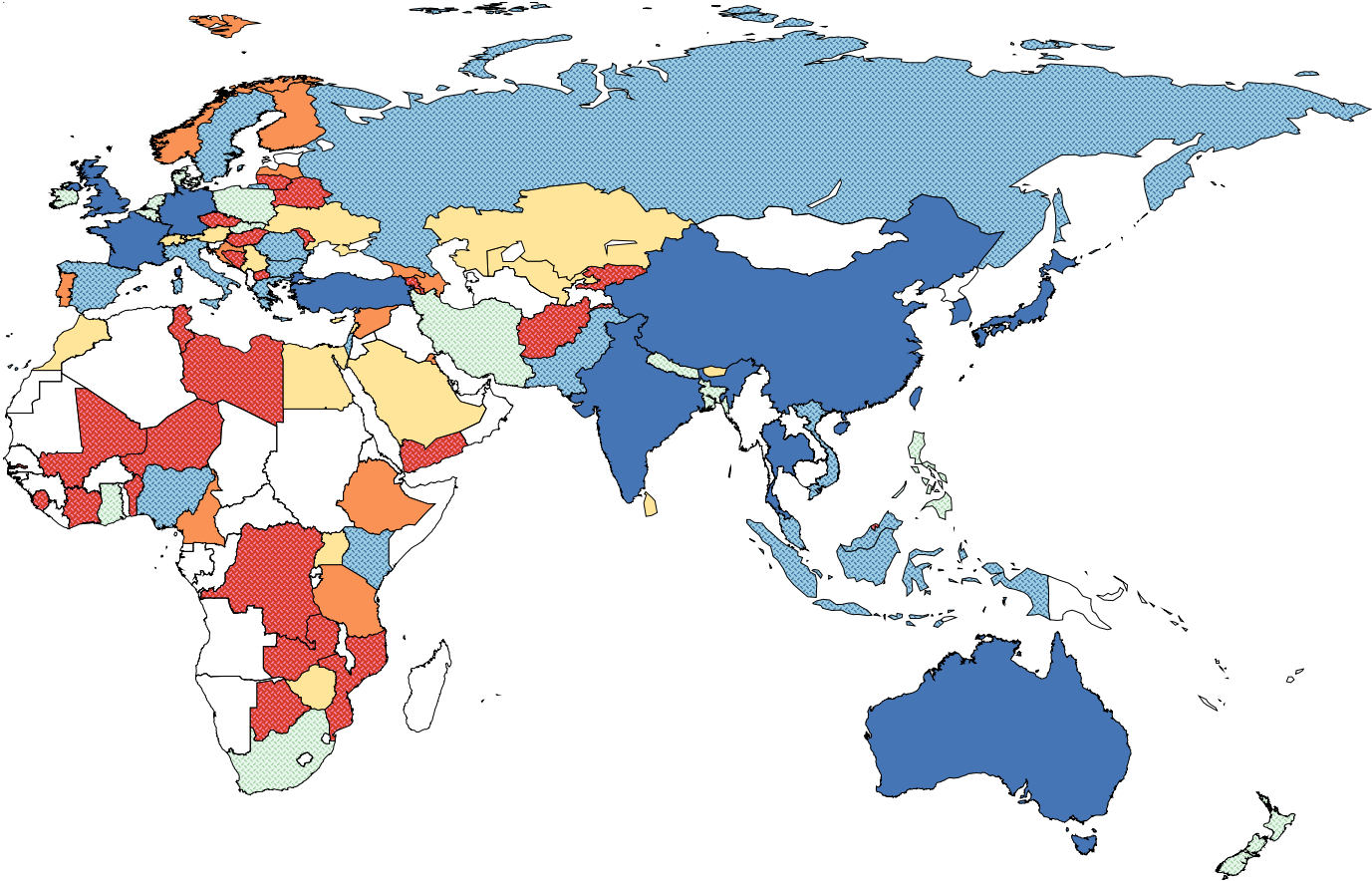
International Undergraduate, Graduate and Professional Student Enrollment Fall 2007

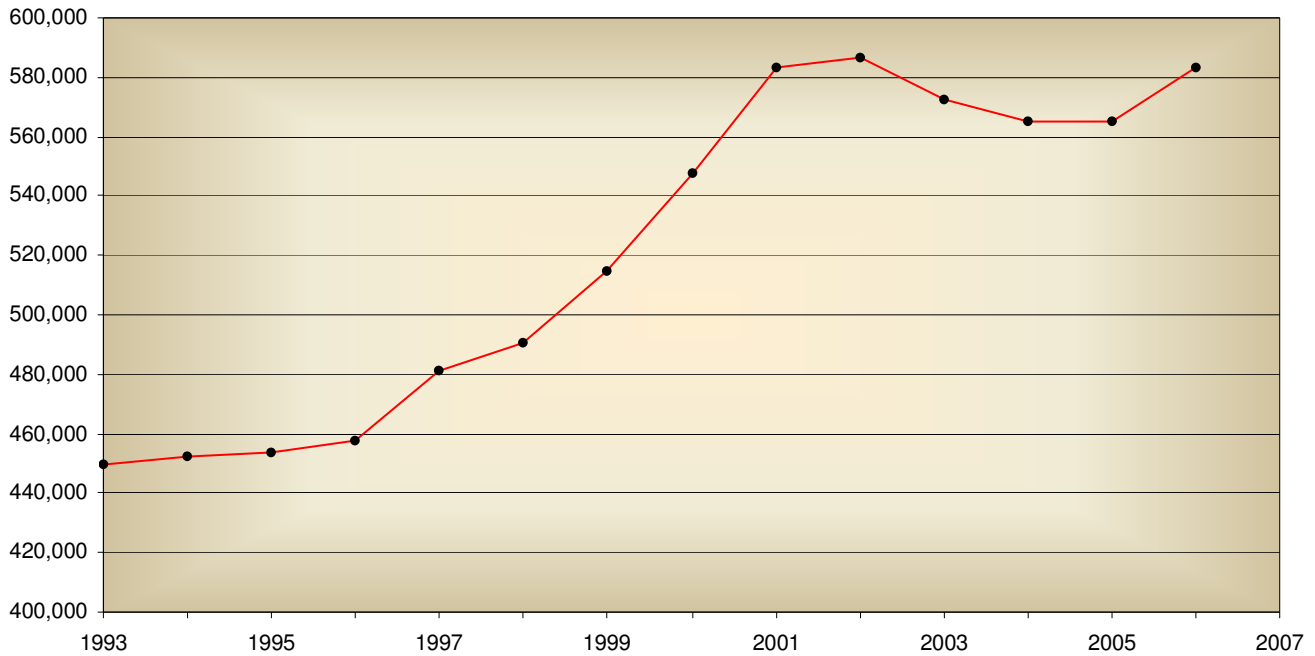


Geographic Distribution

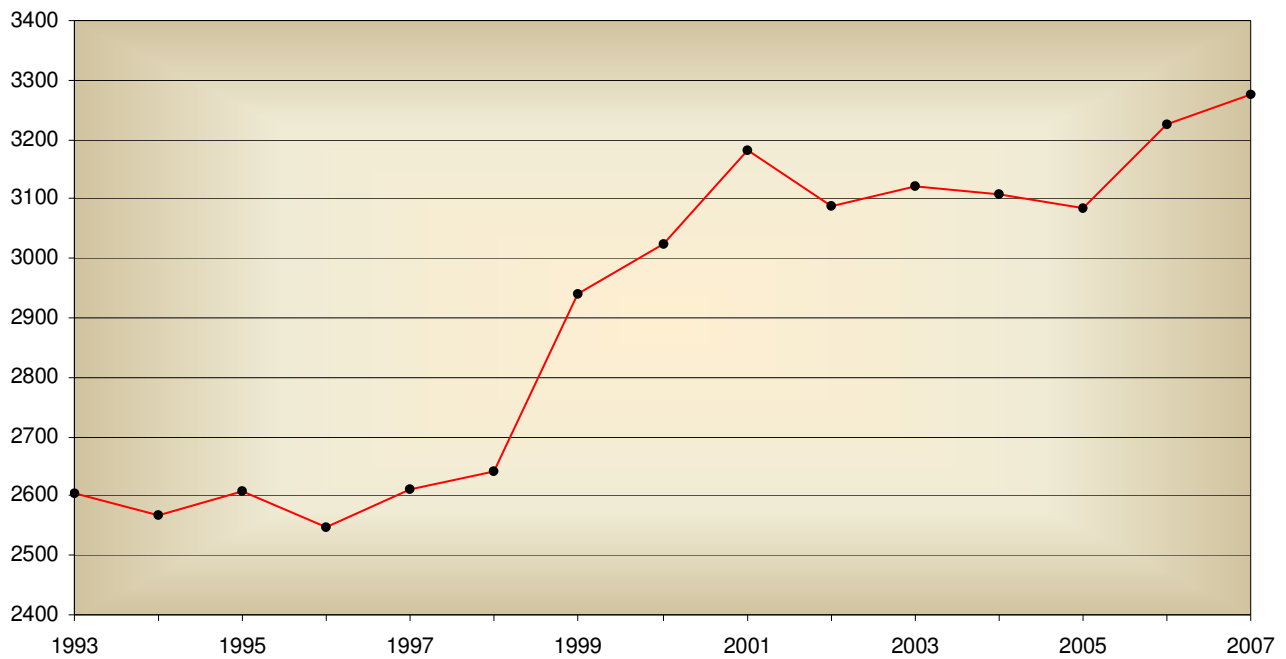

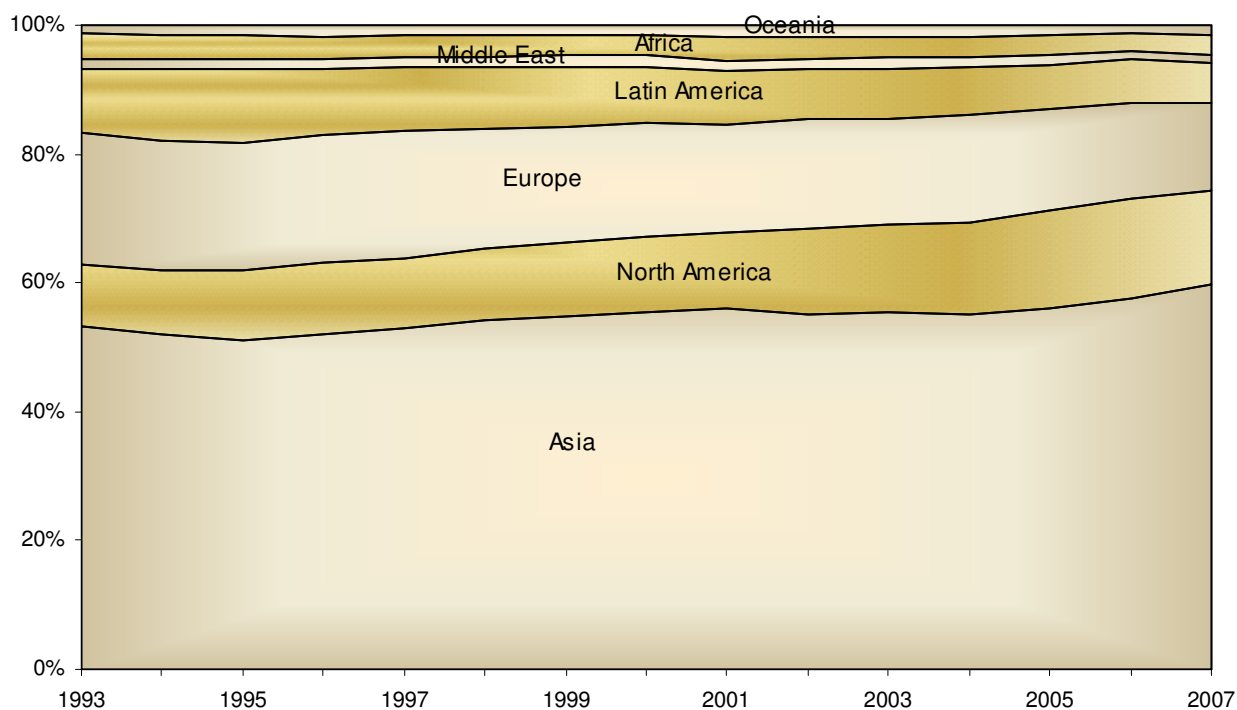

Together, the 2,362 students from these ten countries account for 72.1% of the total international student population at Cornell.

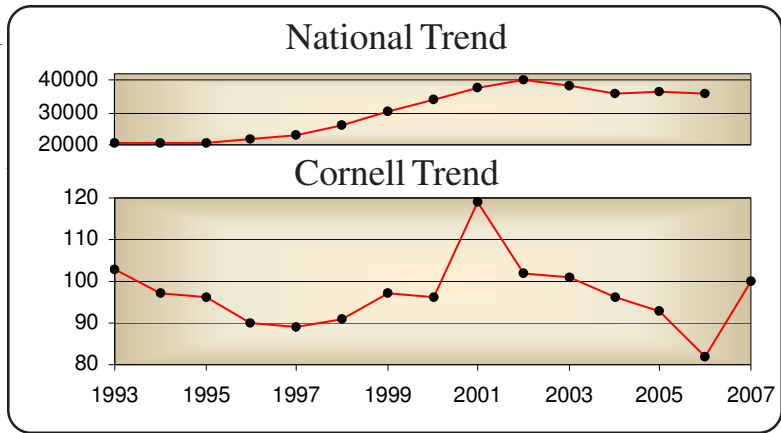
Regional Enrollment Trends 1993-2007



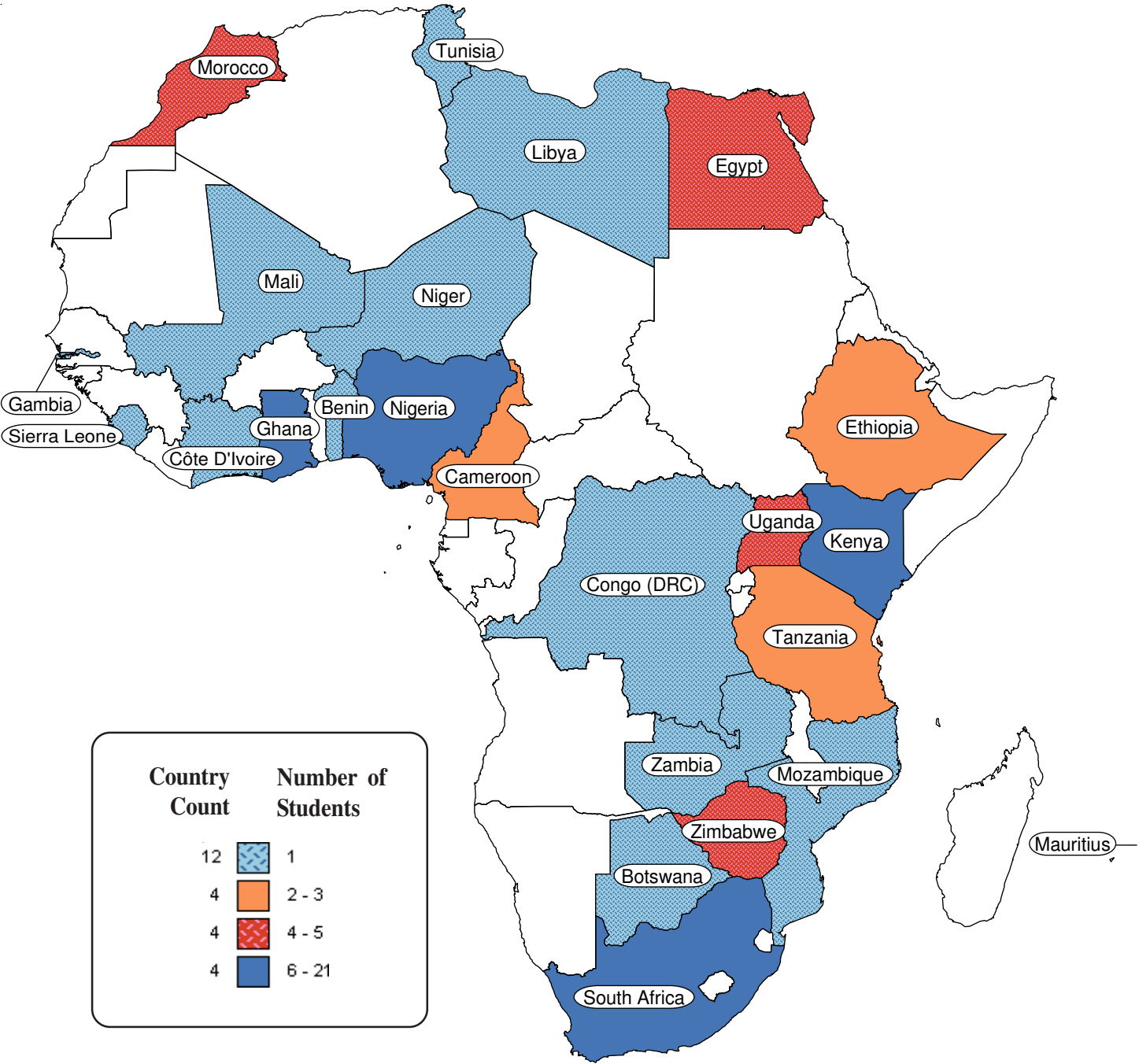

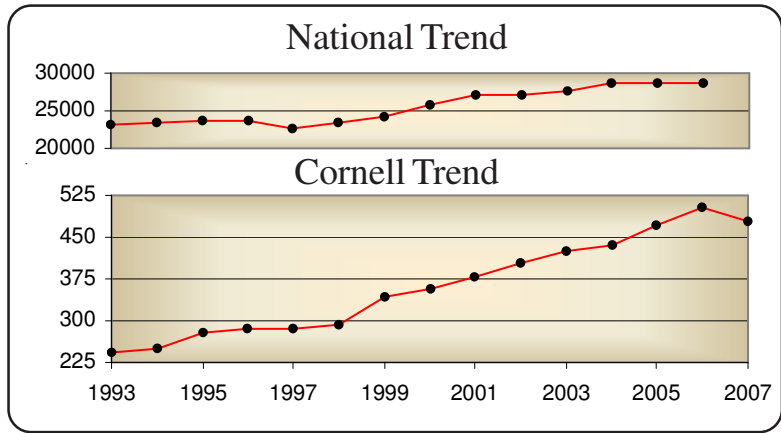

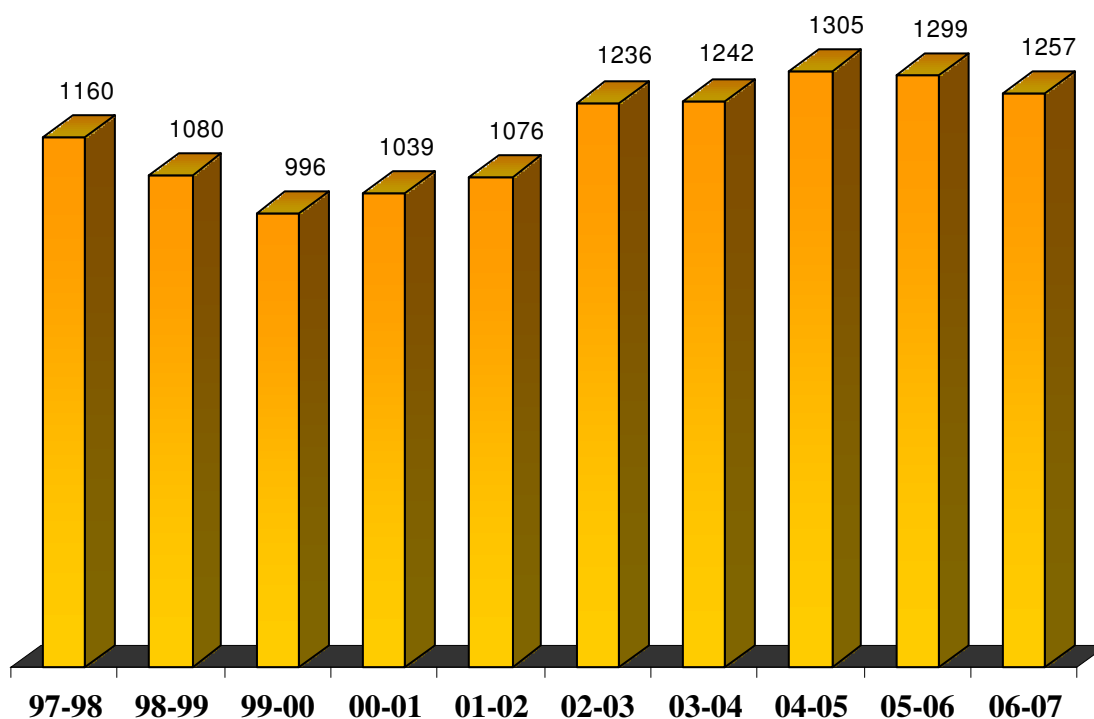

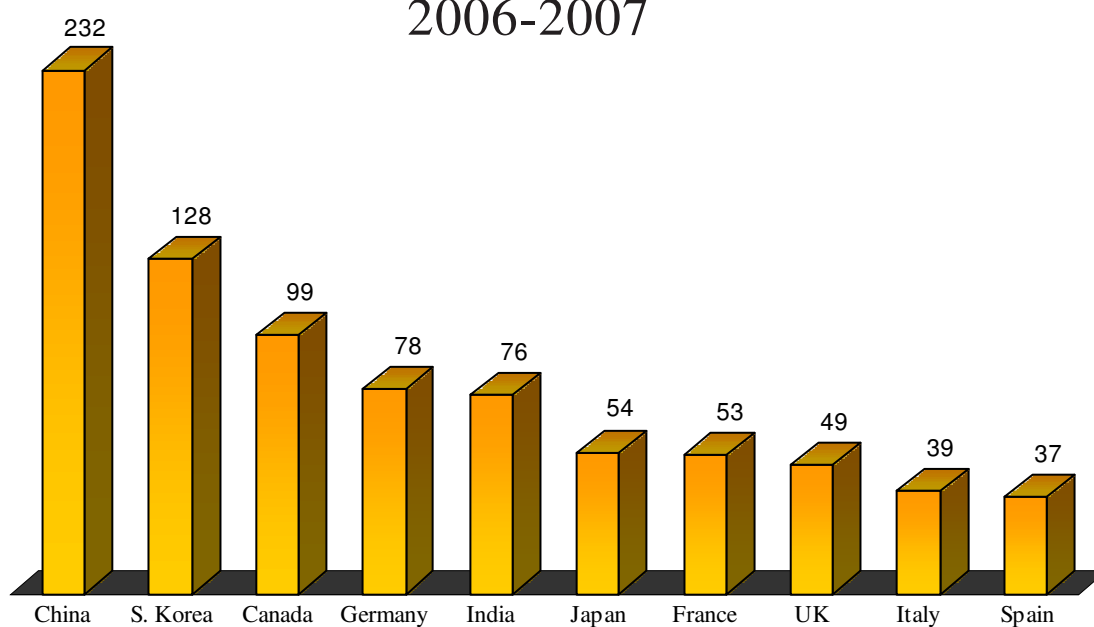
