

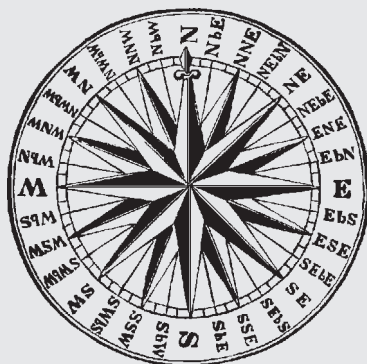

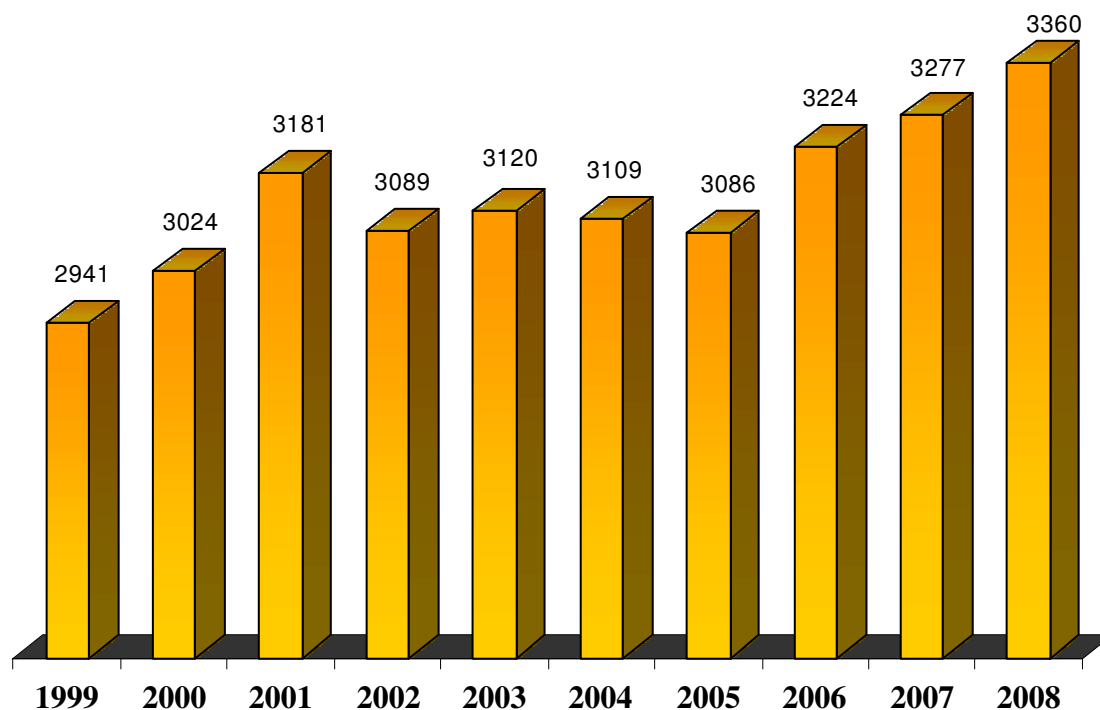

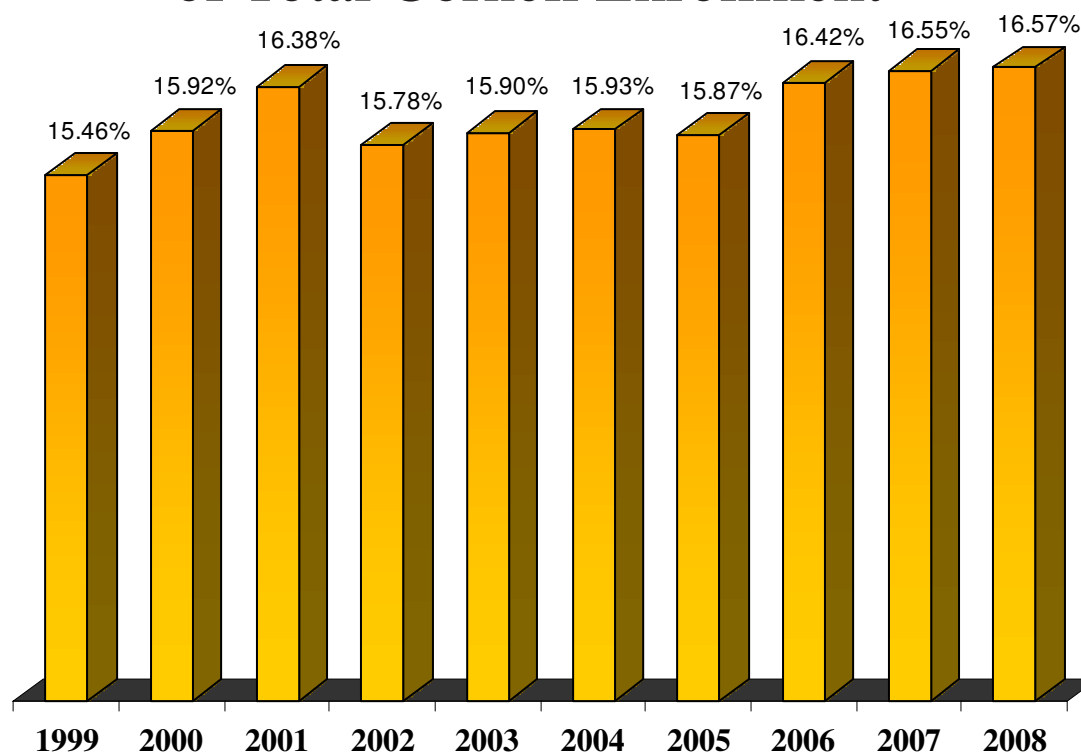

International Students At Cornell University



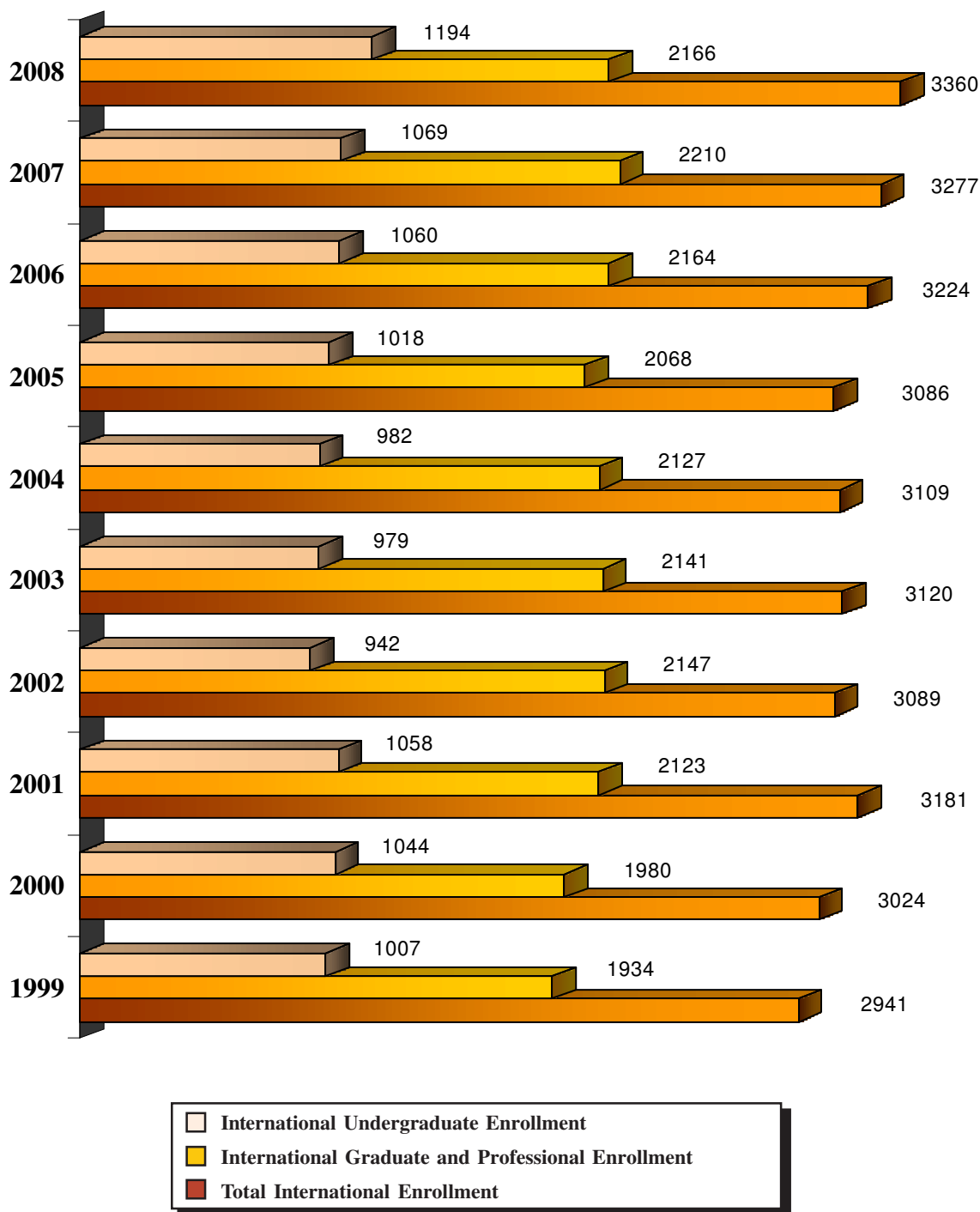
International Students as a Percentage of Total Cornell Enrollment



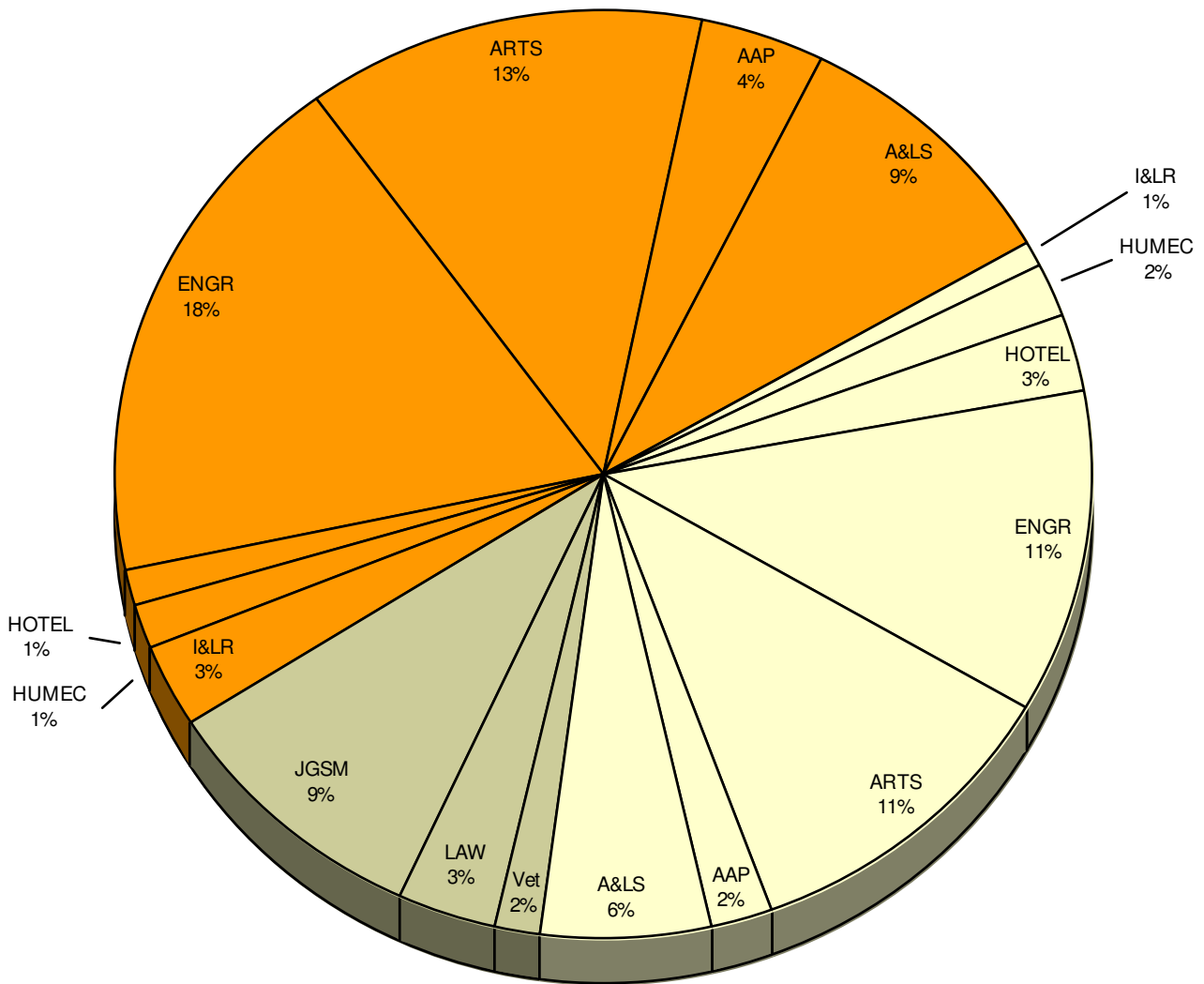
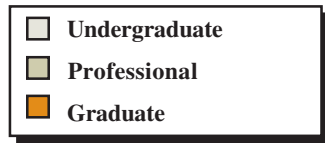

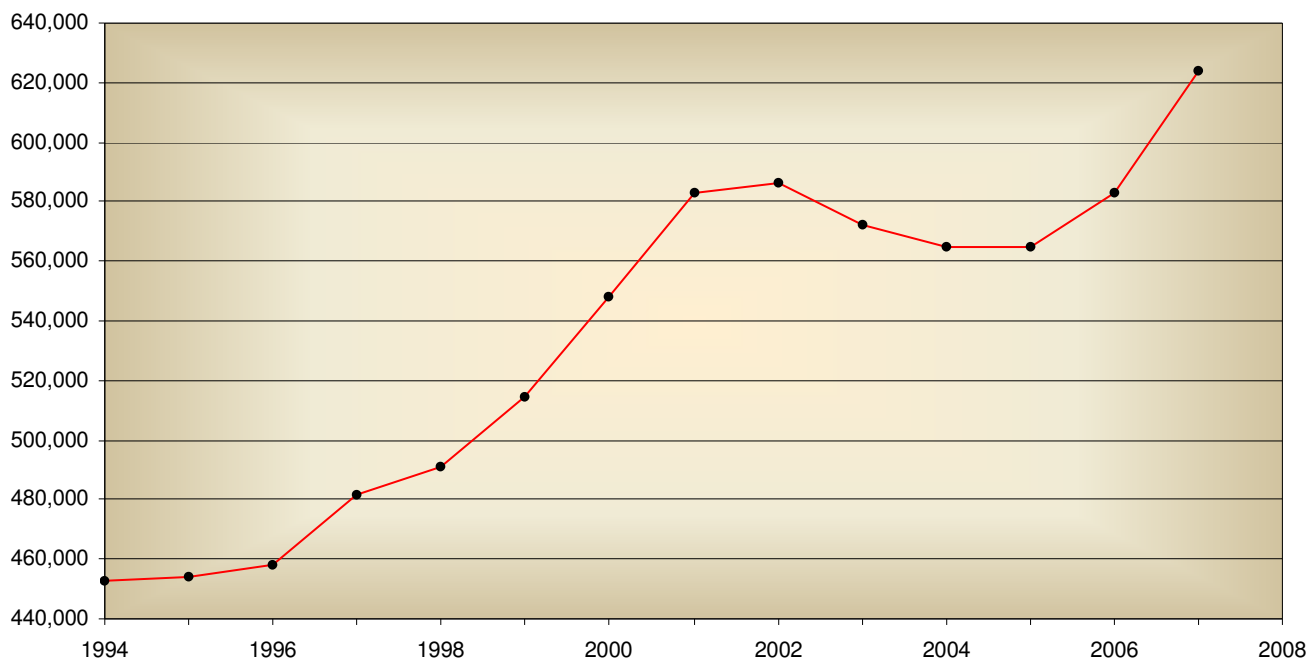


International Undergraduate, Graduate and Professional Student Fields of Study Fall 2008

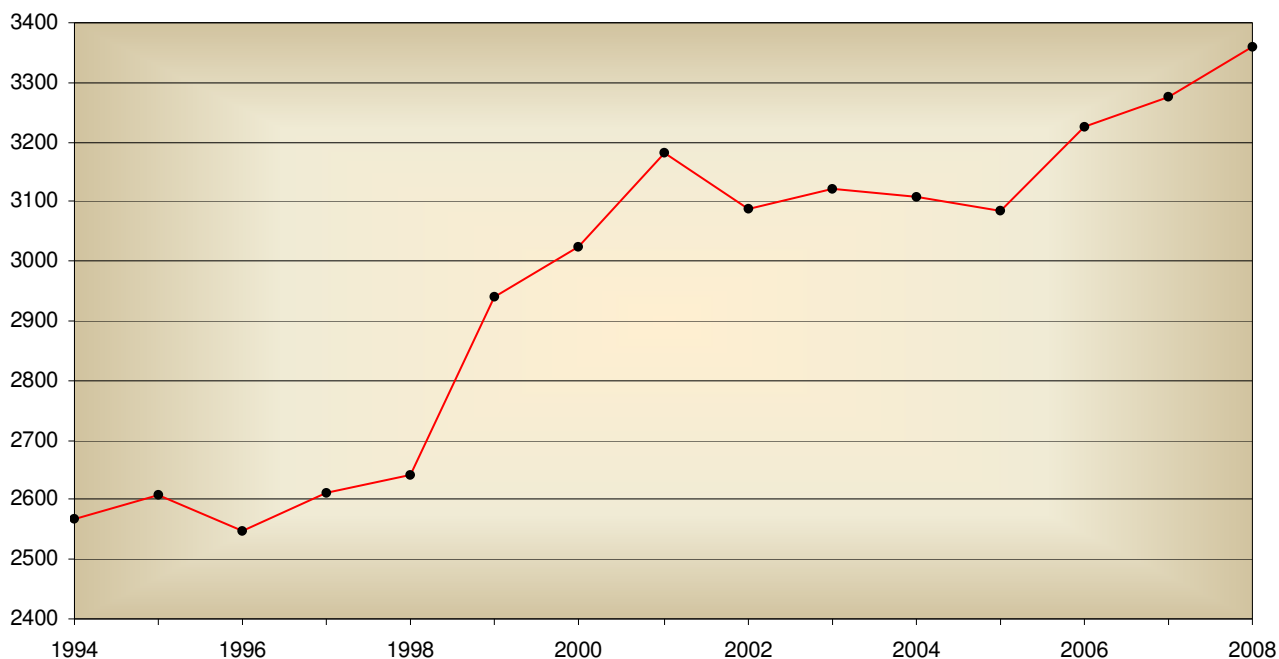


International Enrollment Trends 1993 - 2008

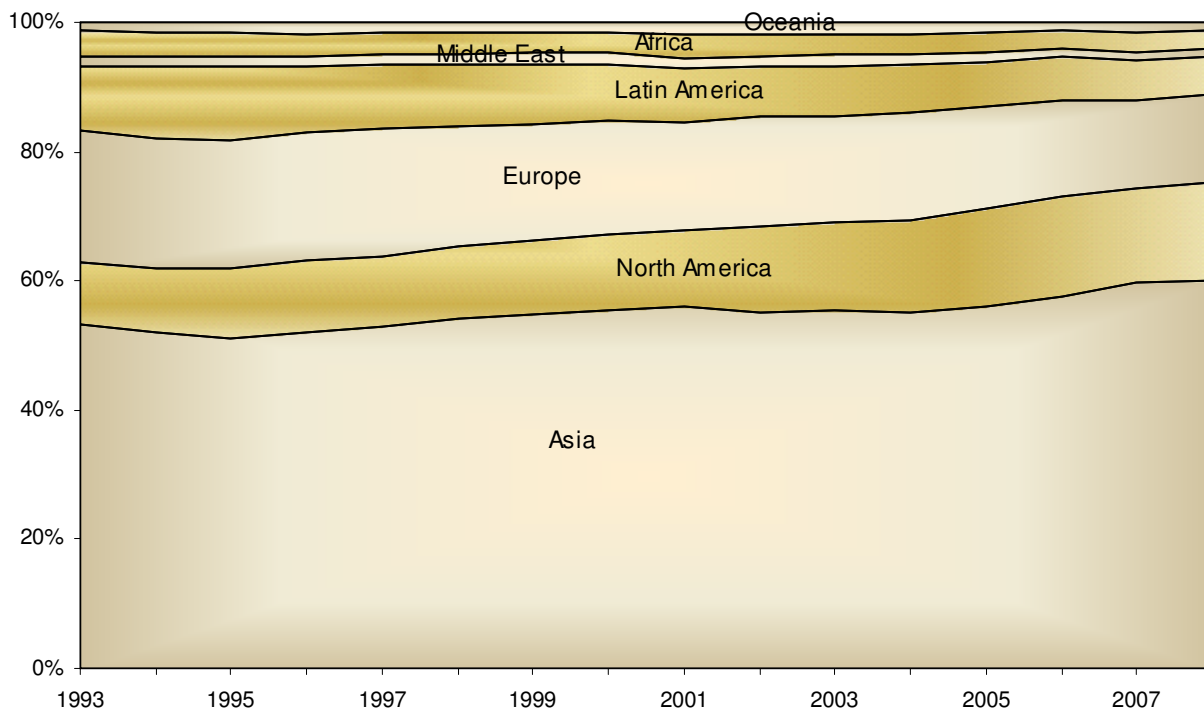

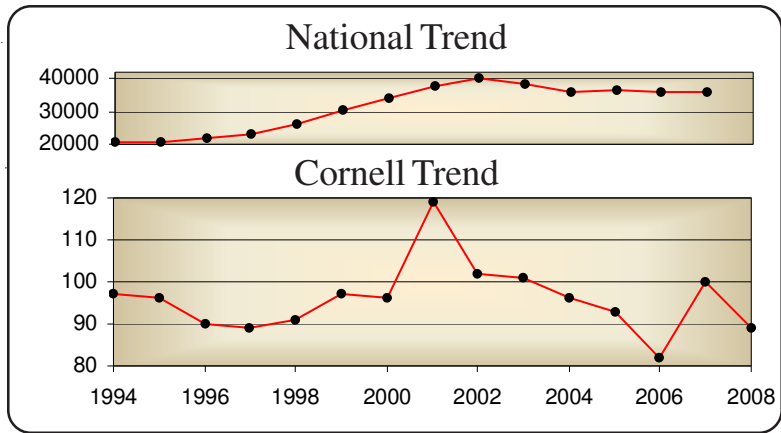
Regional Enrollment Trends 1993-2008



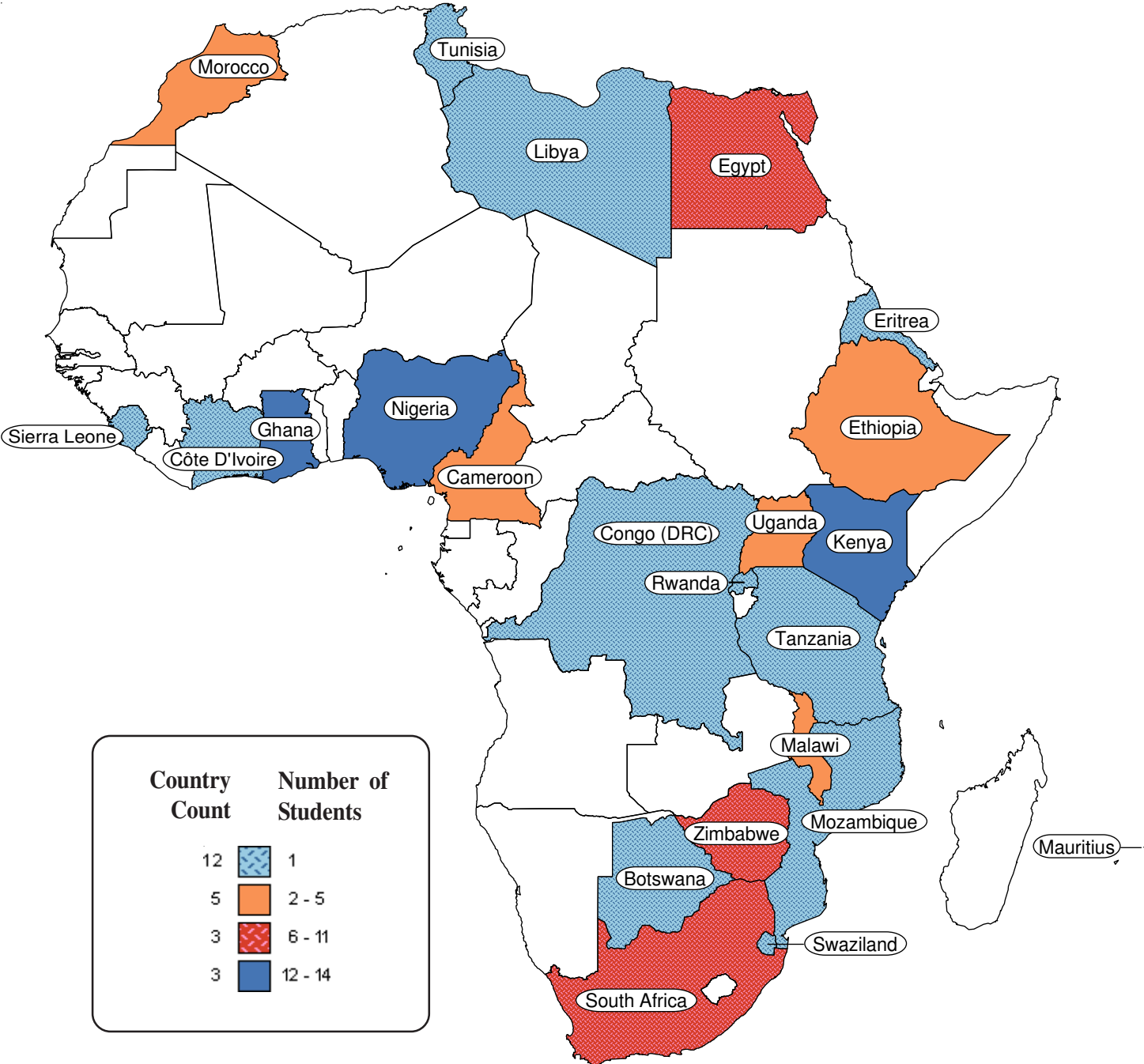

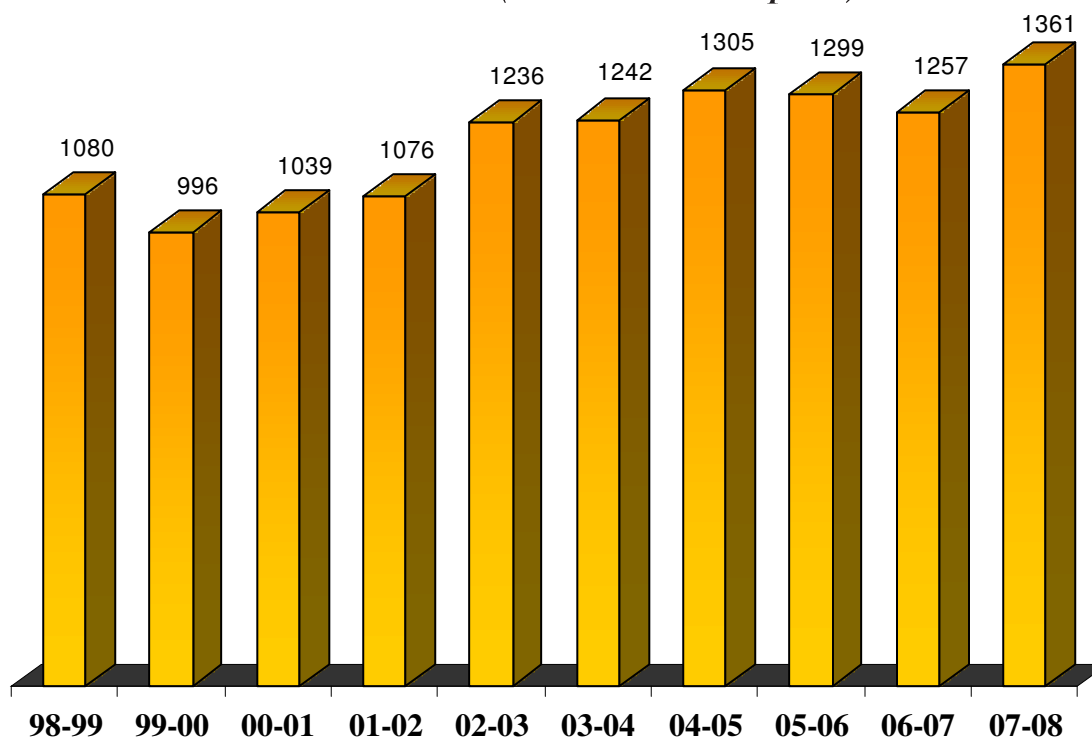
