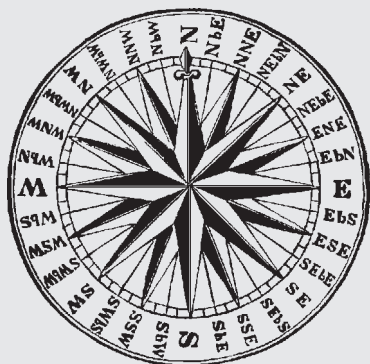

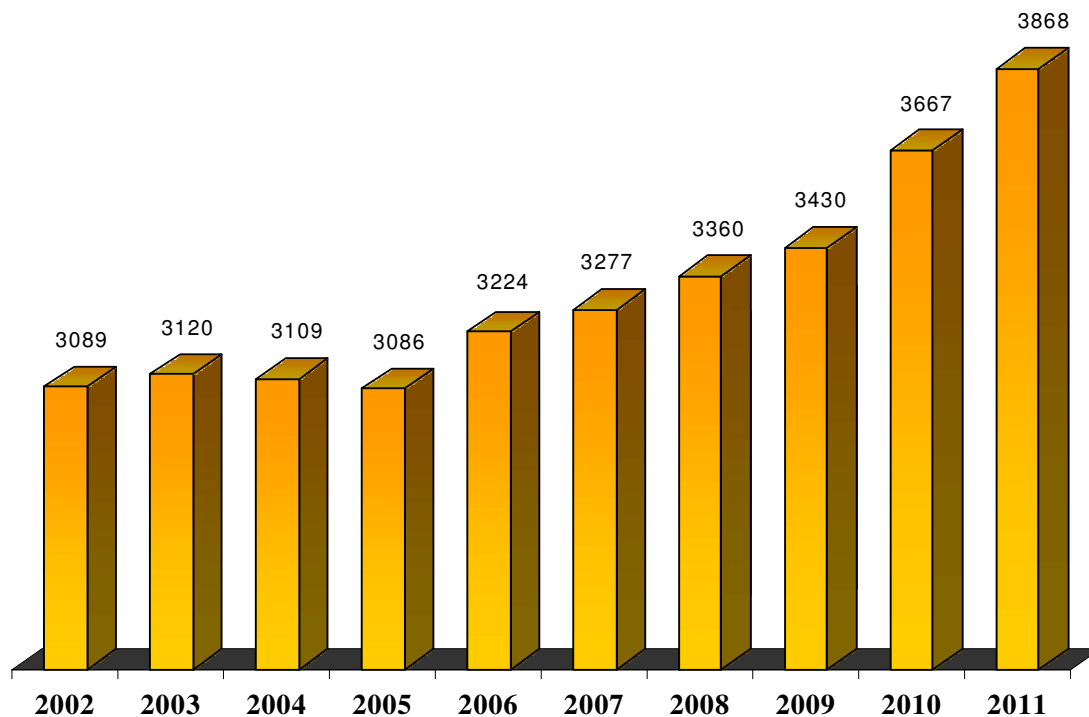

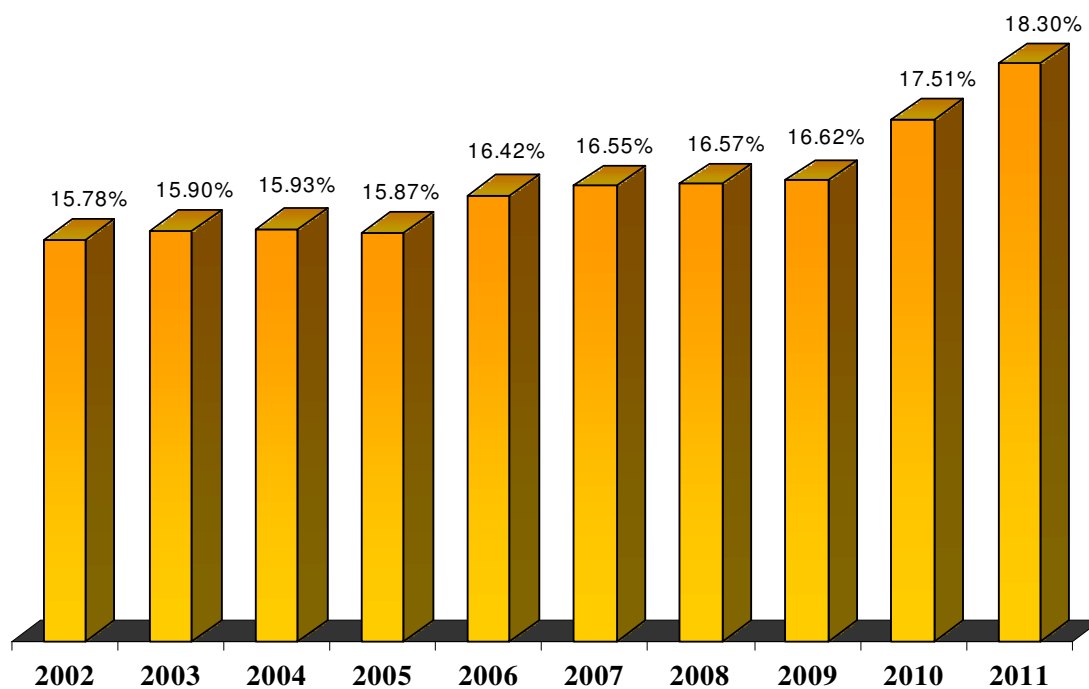

## International Students as a Percentage of Total Cornell Enrollment

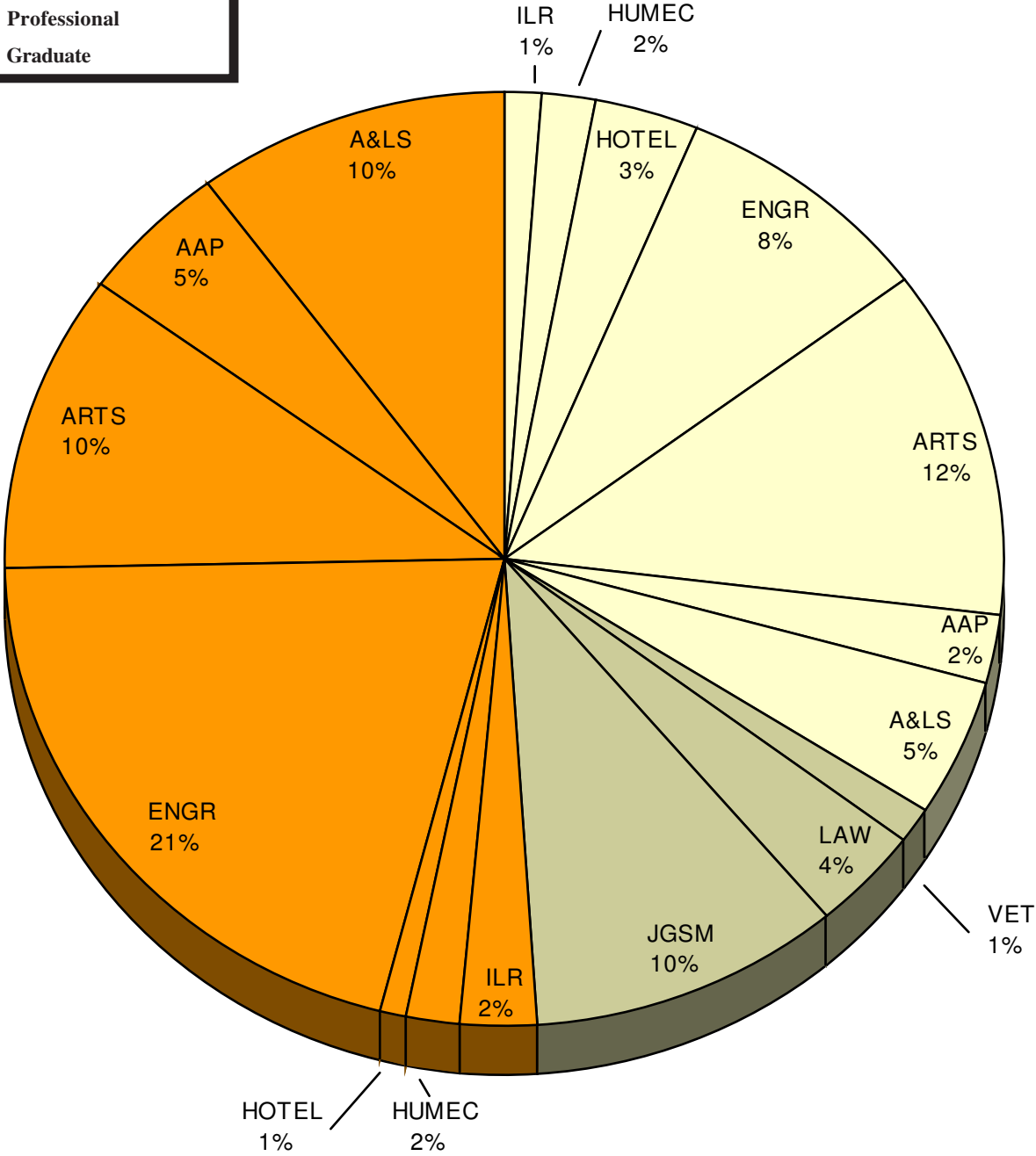
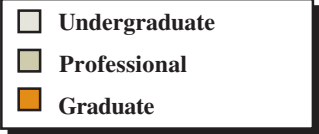

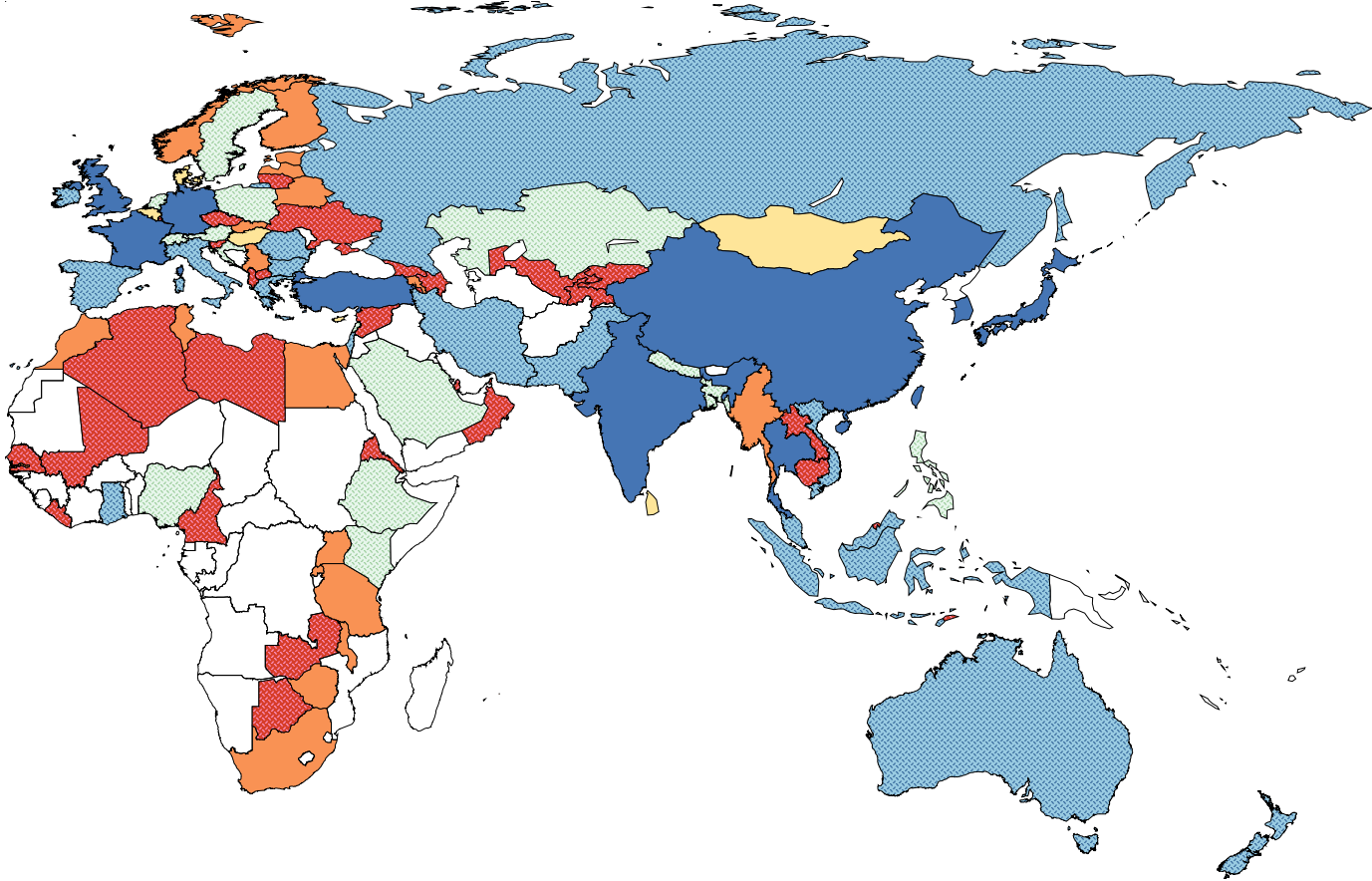

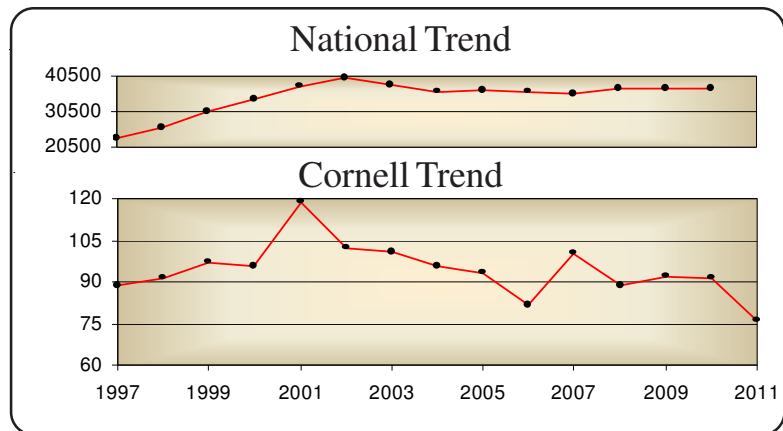
## Regional Enrollment Trends 1997-2011



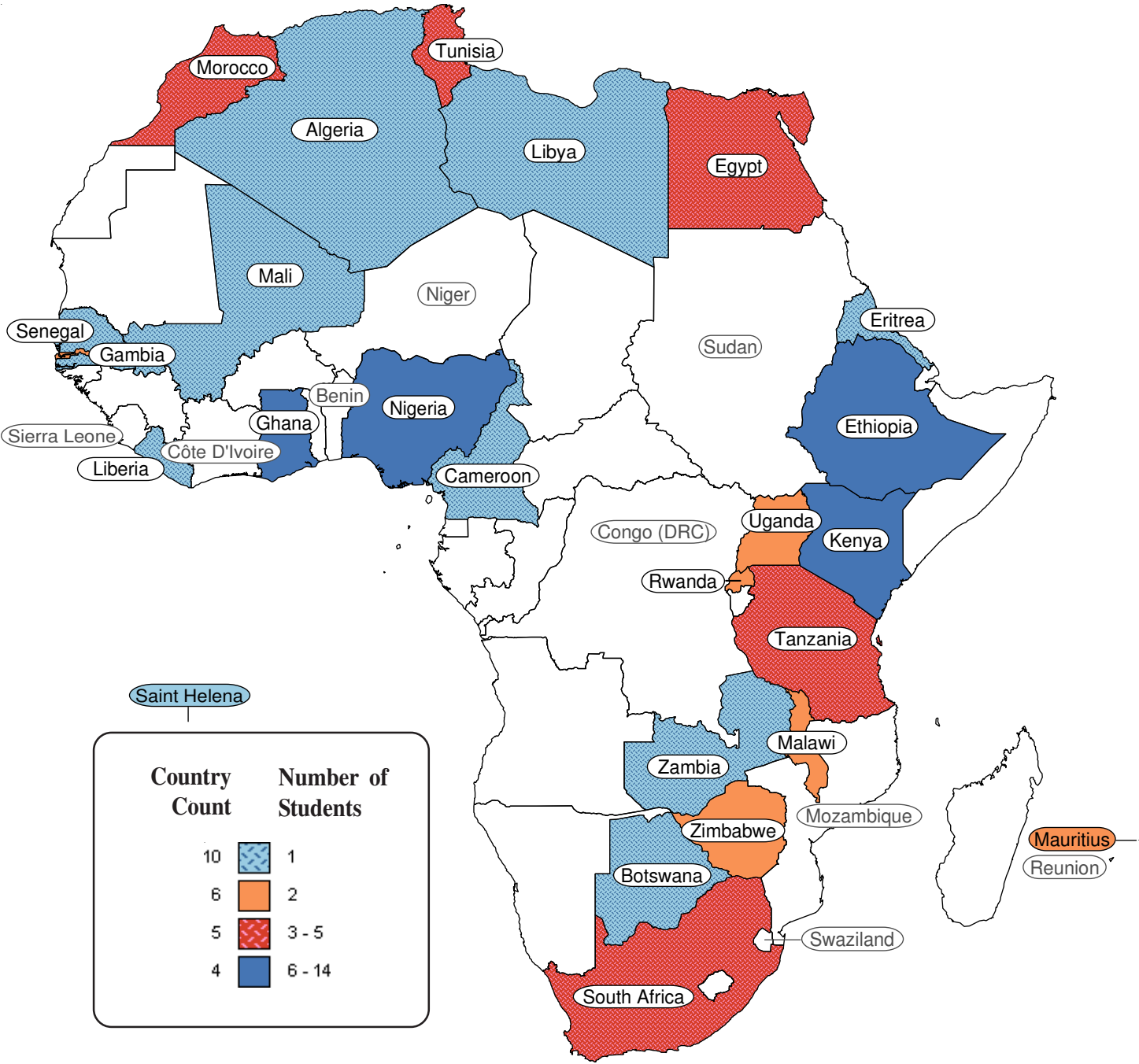
