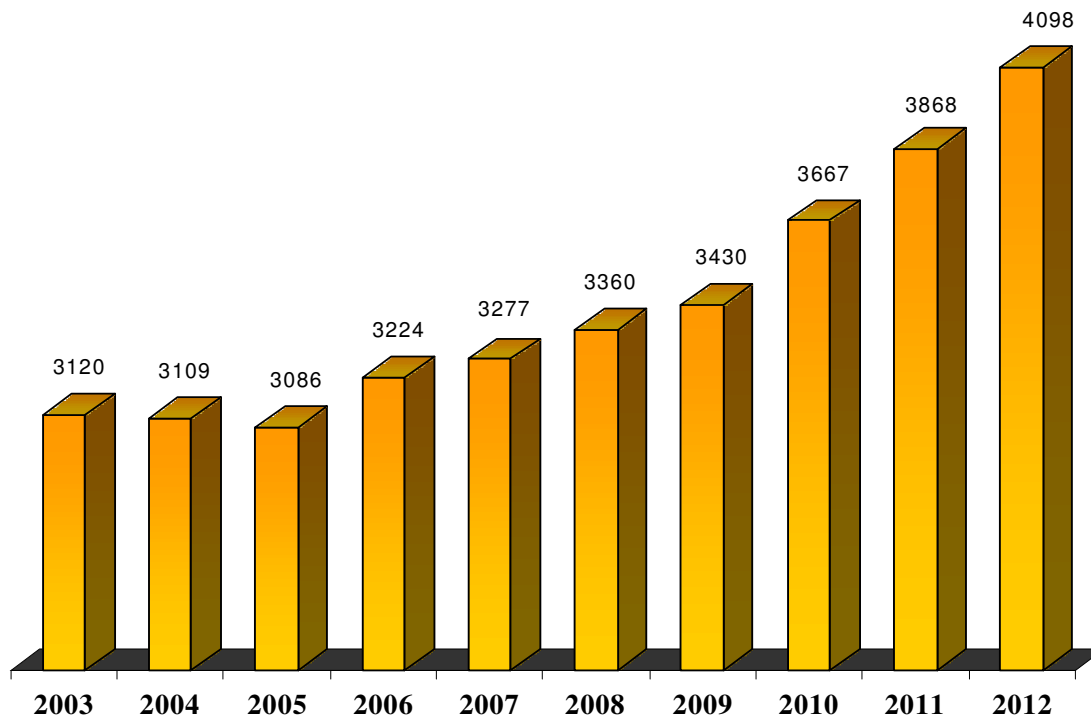

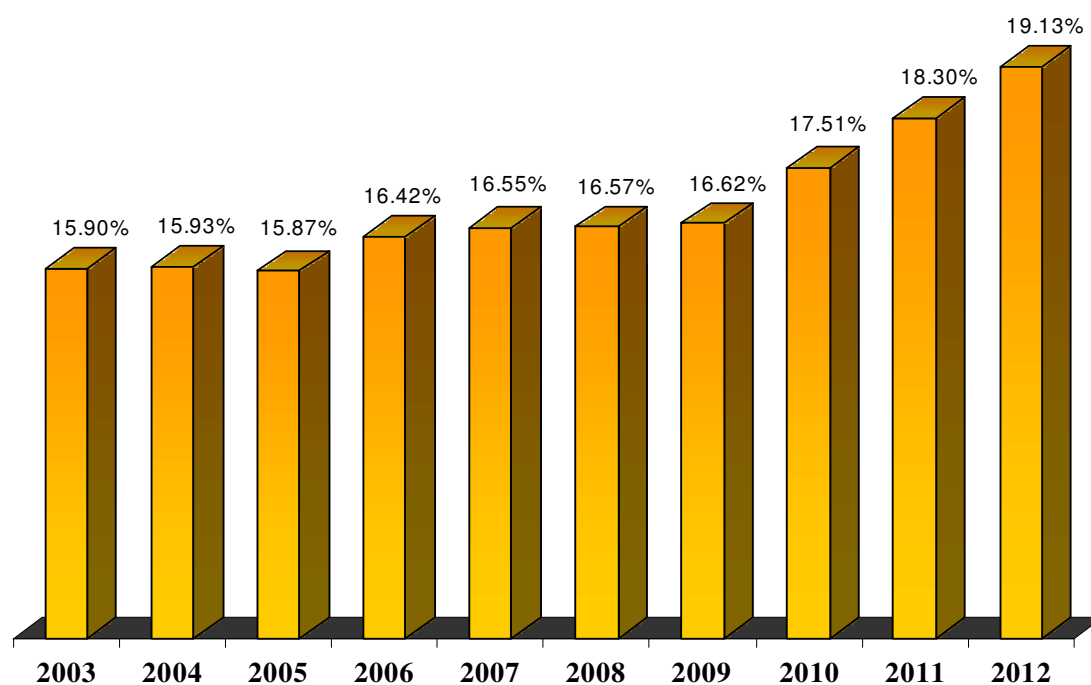

International Students as a Percentage of Total Cornell Enrollment

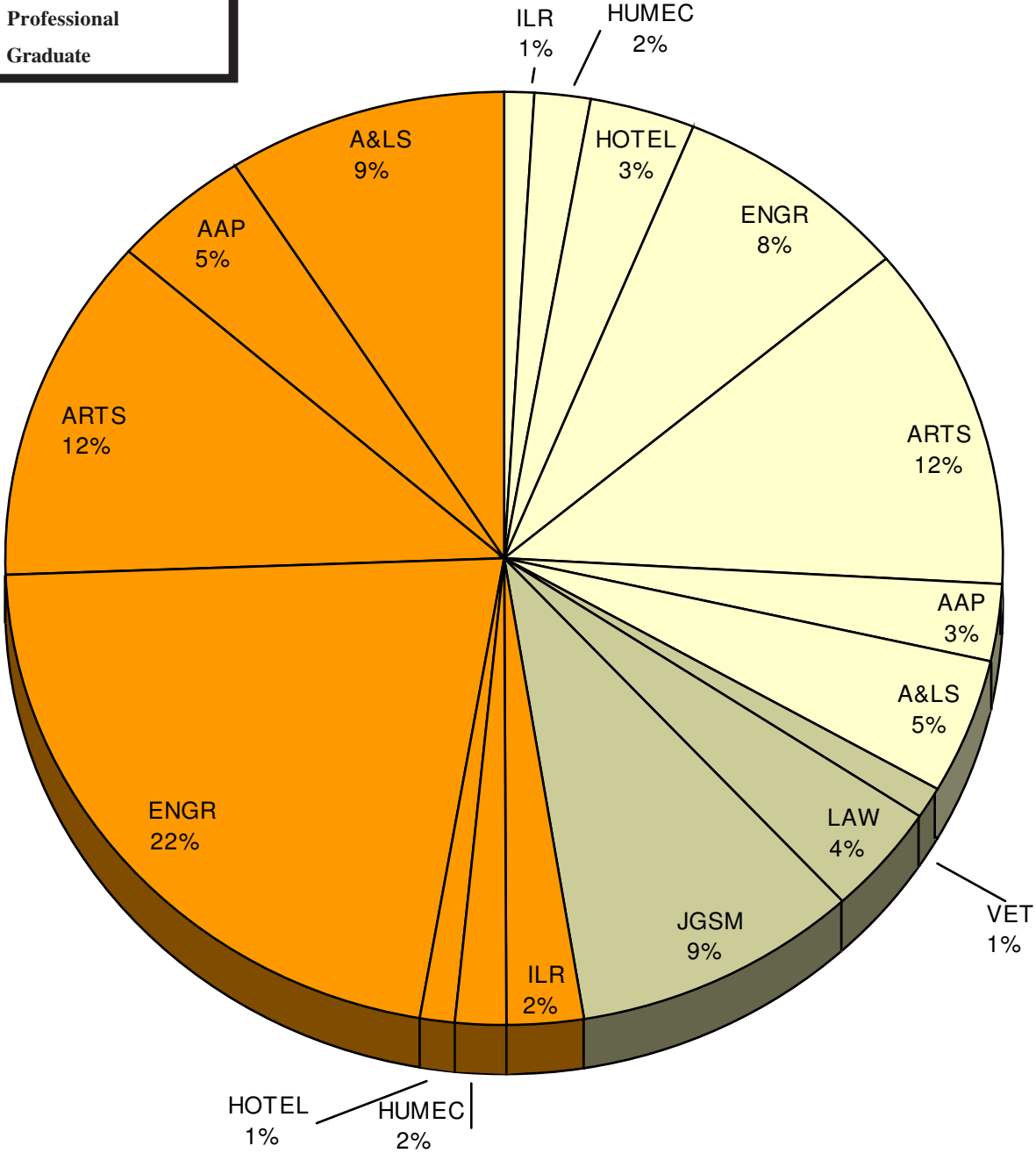
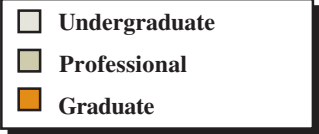

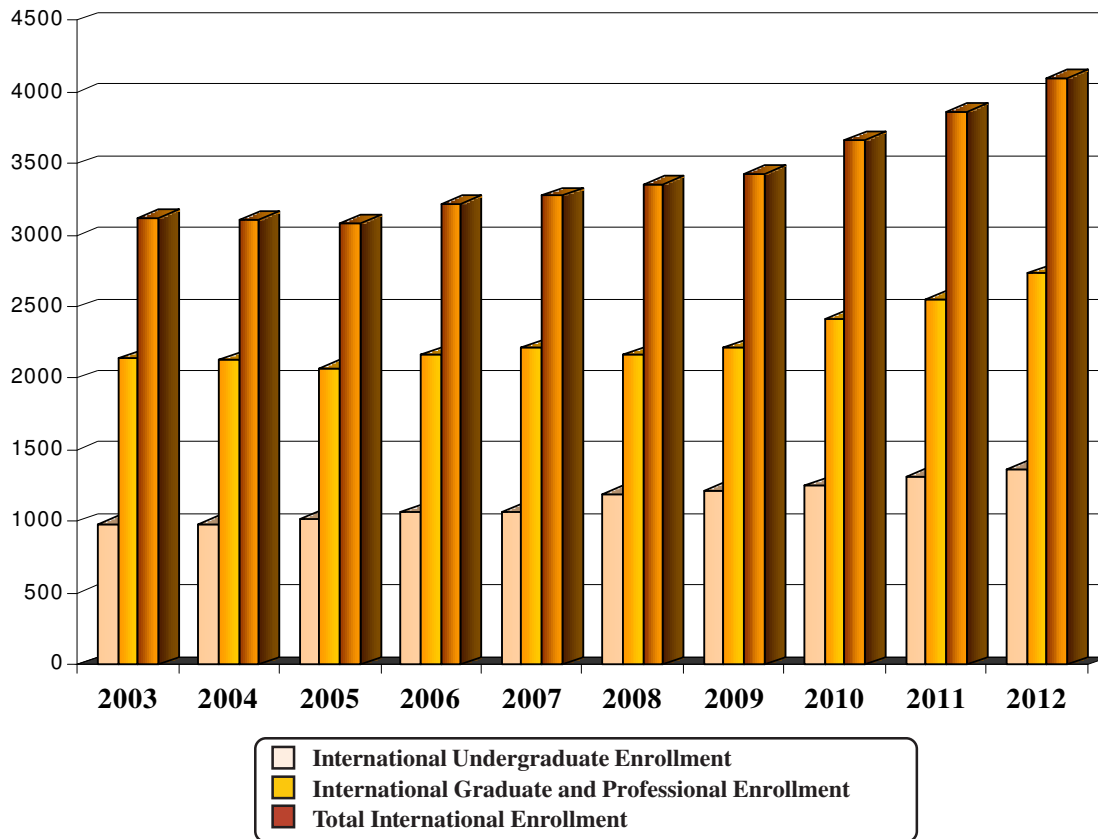

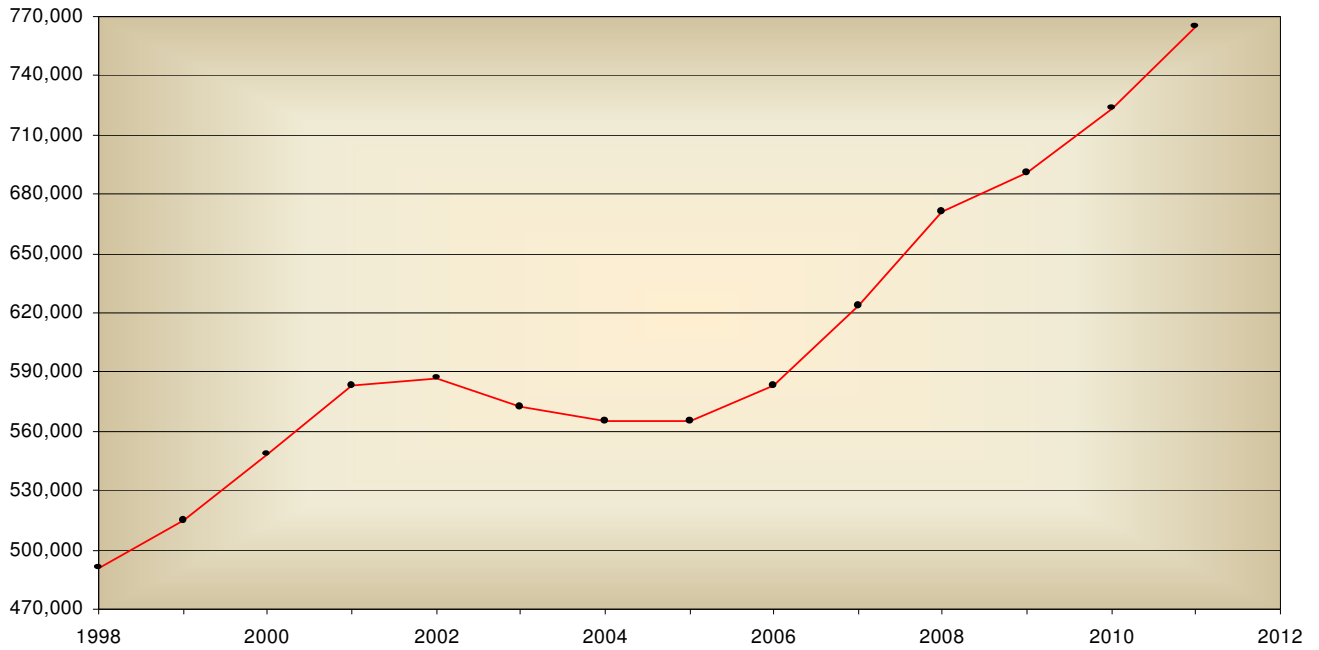

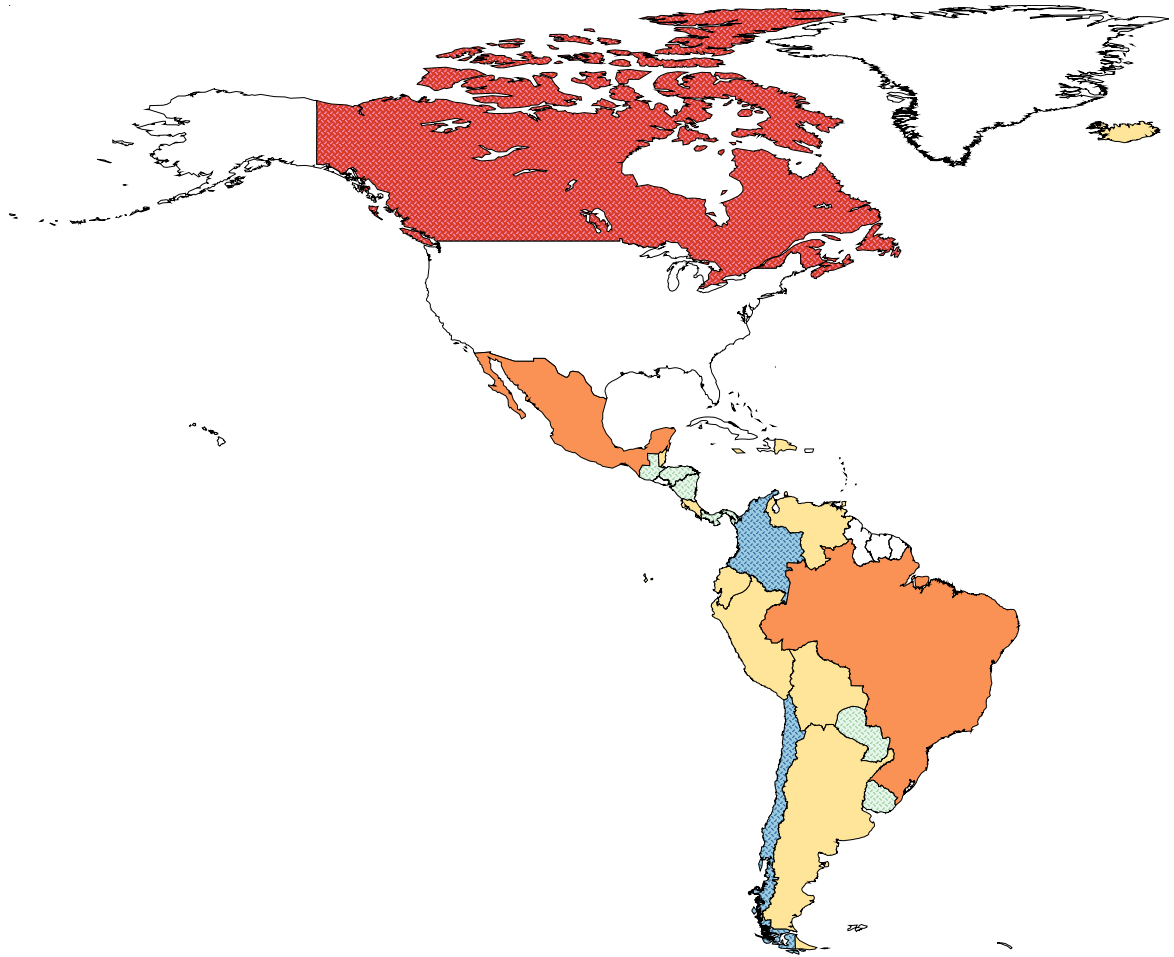
International Enrollment Trends 1998 - 2012

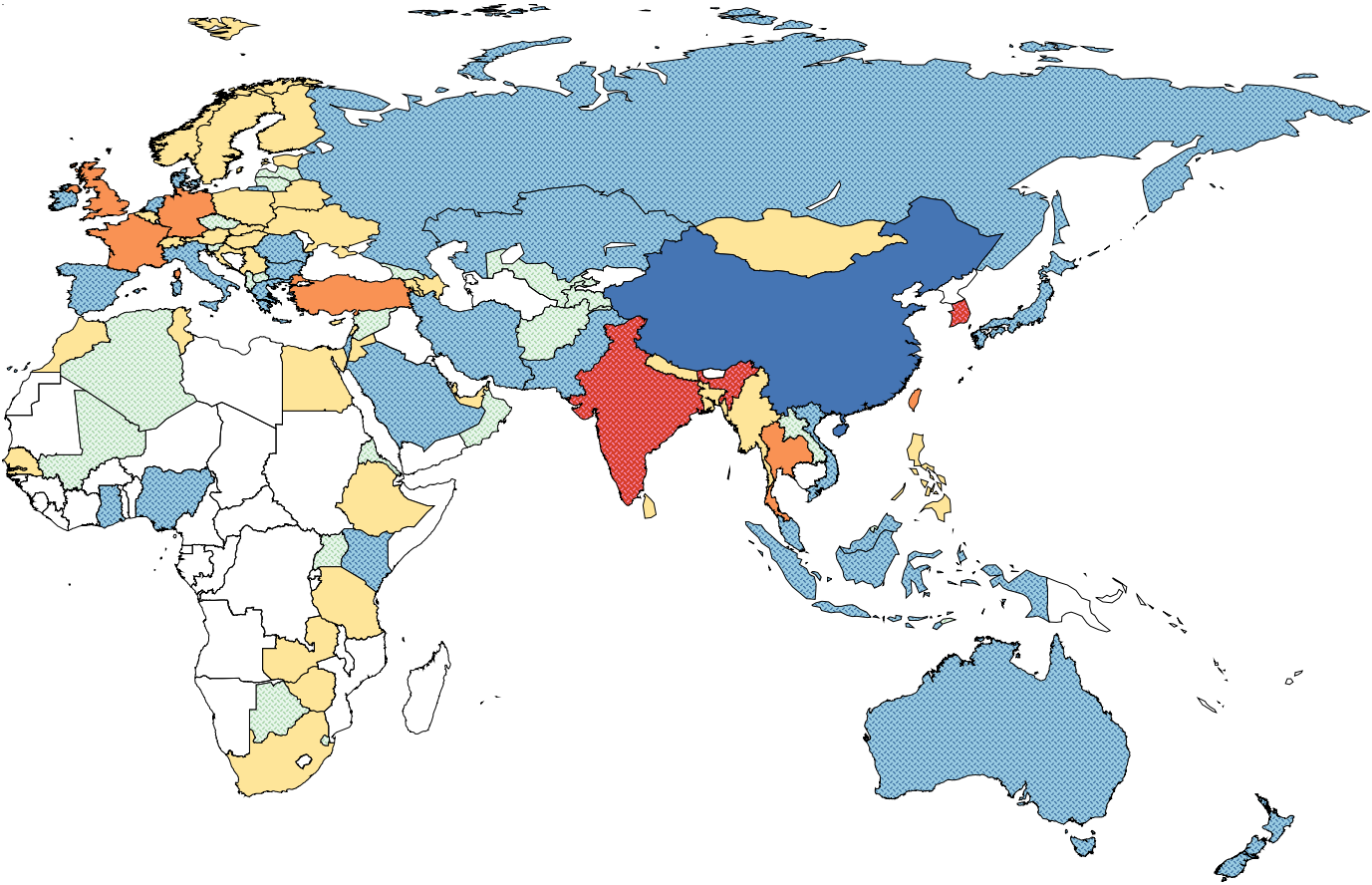

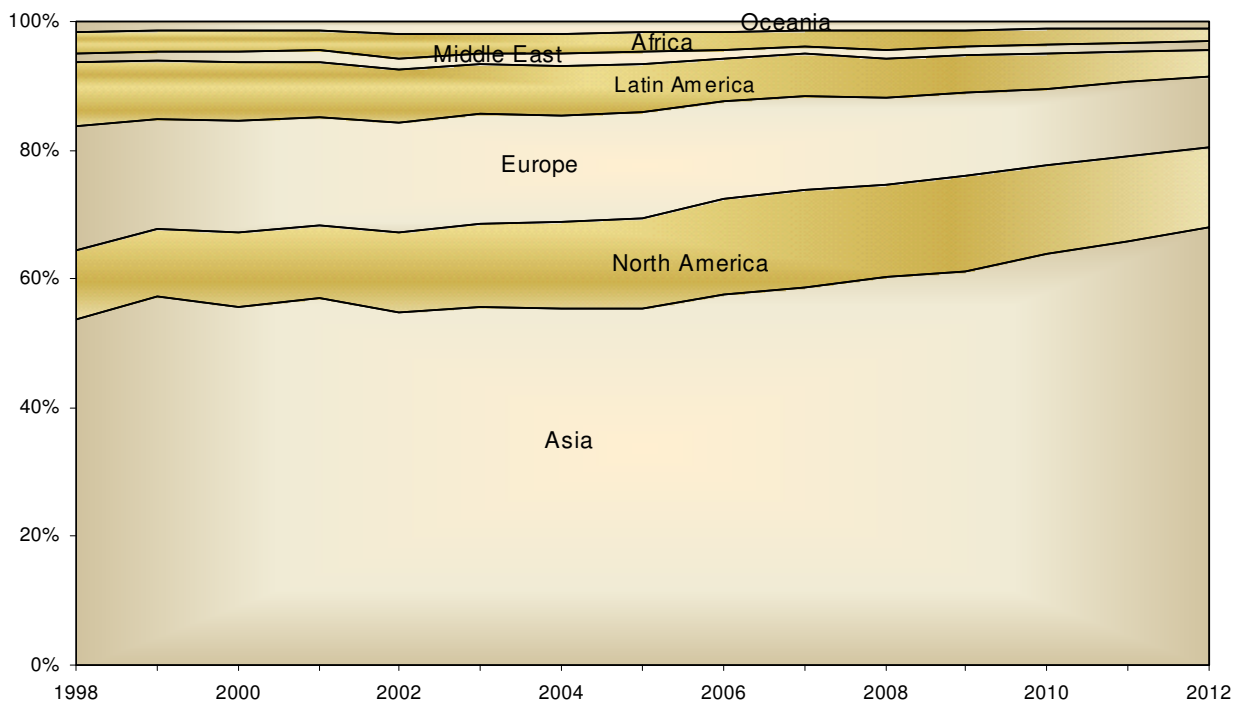

Together, the 3,114 students from these ten countries account for 76.0% of the total international student population at Cornell.

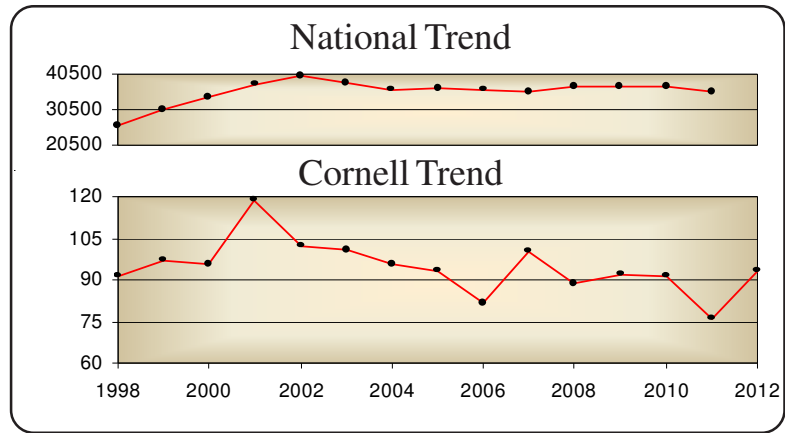
Regional Enrollment Trends 1998-2012



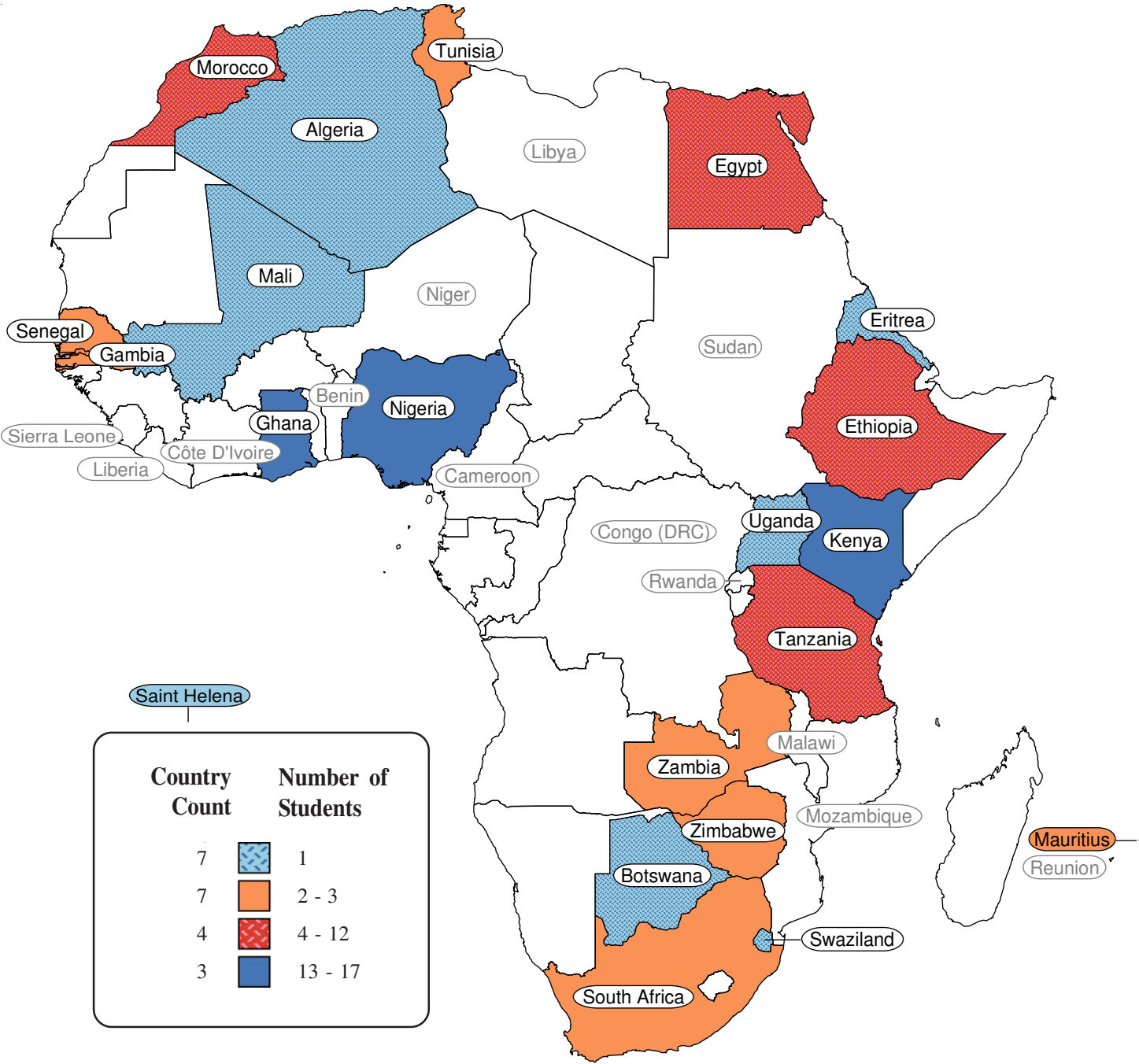
